LABOR DAY FUN FACTS

10 Labor Day Facts

The holiday will be celebrated by families around the country with picnics, barbecues, road trips, and sports events. It is the last blast of the summer vacation season. Labor Day is a federal holiday and most Government offices, schools, and, businesses are closed.



- 1. Labor Day in Canada began in 1872 in Toronto but quickly made its way south to the U.S. Originally it began as a significant demonstration demanding rights for workers.
- 2. The first U.S. Labor Day was celebrated on Tuesday, September 5, 1882, in New York City, planned by the Central Labor Union. The Labor Day parade of about 10,000 workers took unpaid leave and marched from City Hall past Union Square uptown to 42nd street, and ended in Wendel's Elm Park at 92nd Street and 9th Avenue for a concert, speeches, and a picnic.
- 3. Oregon was the first state to make Labor Day a holiday in 1887.
- 4. On June 28, 1894, Congress passed an act making the first Monday in September of each year a legal holiday in the District of Columbia and the territories.
- 5. What are we celebrating? The contributions and achievements of the 155 million men and women who are in the U.S. workforce. (this number is 10 years old so it may not be accurate-ks)
- 6. In the late 1800s the average American worked 12-hour days and seven-day weeks to eke out a basic living. Children as young as 5-6 years old worked in factories and mines.
- 7. The year in which the 8-hour day was firmly established was 1916 with the passage of the Adamson Act. This was the first federal law regulating hours of workers in private companies.
- 8. Traditionally people did not wear white or seersucker clothes after Labor Day as it unofficially marked the end of summer.
- 9. The football season starts on or around Labor Day and many teams play their first game of the year during Labor Day weekend.
- 10. Labor Day is viewed as the unofficial last day of vacation before the start of the new school year (and mourned by students all over). Stated differently, it is the Back-to-School kickoff (cheered by parents all over!).

So take some time during this last summer hurral to relax, enjoy the family, and enjoy the end of summer!

Coyotes in Palm Hill

ollowing the presentation, these officials visited known sites where coyotes have lingered with a few residents and offered their suggestions for follow-up.

Here are suggestions for us implement:

- 1. Enclose around base of any coaches that are open;
- 2. DO NOT leave any food/seed outside for animals;
- 3. Daily pick up any fallen fruit or palm tree seeds on ground;
- 4. Put trash out morning of pick-up and if birds get into bag consider double bagging to prevent this;
- 5. Keep small pets on short leashes when walking;
- 6. Practice repeated hazing (such as making disruptive noises at high volume, squirting water, to send coyotes out of the area.)

EVERYONE MUST FOLLOW THESE GUIDELINES IF WE ARE TO BE SUCCESSFUL IN

REDUCING COYOTE POPULATION IN PALM HILL!

If you walk around Palm Hill carry a device that will make noise if you encounter a coyote, such as a can with coins in it, a horn, or other noisy distraction.

Officer Criswell is willing to come to Palm Hill and work with a group of interested residents to practice hazing and show us that we don't need to fear coyotes but to be persistent with these techniques to disrupt their environment.

While your Board of Directors has approved hiring a trapper to reduce our current coyote numbers these officials said that will not solve the prevalence of coyotes in our park. We must all take steps listed above to upset the coyotes from considering Palm Hill a peaceful place to roam.

We must work to minimize their comfort level and learn that we cannot eradicate them, only reduce their ease in Palm Hill. Pinellas County has the largest concentration of coyotes in Florida. If we implement these strategies we should experience fewer sightings in our community after they periodically clear out the rabbit population.



RULES & REGULATIONS



Rental Periods:



2. No unit may be rented or leased by a Member for a period of less than three (3) consecutive months.

Important

3. Members may not authorize sub-letting in leases and Renters may not sublet units. Neither Members, except for those who have leased their units, nor Renters may permit others to occupy the unit in the Renter's or Member's absence from the unit unless the occupant is an invited non - paying guest or other approved resident occupant.

Why Should I Register My Vehicles?

We want to ensure that vehicles in the park using overflow parking, actually belong to residents, renters, and guests.

- In the case of an emergency, evacuation, or a natural disaster, we need to know who is in the park for us to check on your well-being.
- If there is an emergency, medical or other, and a vehicle is parked on the street blocking the roadway, we need to know who to contact to have the vehicle moved to allow immediate access.
- Vehicles parked on the streets can and do block large emergency vehicles' (fire trucks, ambulances etc.) access to a homeowner's residence. Please, for the health and safety of your family, friends, and neighbors, register your vehicles!
- If you have replaced a windshield contact the office for a replacement decal.
- If you have sold your vehicle and purchased a new vehicle register the new vehicle and obtain a new decal. (Inform the office of this replacement).
- If you have changed your vehicle license in anyway (i.e., handicap, disabled, veteran, change from another state to a Florida license). This information needs to be updated in the office.
- The form is available in the office and can also be sent to you via email if you wish.

Palm Hill Decals & Parking Permits

<u>Owners/Residents of Palm Hill Country Club</u> - Need to be sure that all their vehicles are registered and have a Palm Hill decal. This decal is to be placed on the driver's side bottom of the windshield, allowing the decal numbers to be always visible.

Renters - Need to be sure they are displaying the parking permit on their vehicle while it is on Palm Hill property. This means in your driveway or when parking anywhere on the property.

<u>Visitors</u> - Visitors parking on Palm Hill property even overnight must have a parking permit displayed on their vehicle while parking not only in a driveway but when parking anywhere in the park. The permit must be displayed to show the home being visited and the dates. Their hosts should obtain the permit at the office any time prior to their guests' arrival.

<u>Violations</u> – If you get a violation on your windshield, this means only that you need to register and get a decal or a parking permit. Decals and permits are provided at the office Monday through Friday; however, the parking permit may be obtained any time prior to the visit. The only information required is the address and the dates of the visit. If you have any questions, please contact the office at 727-581-8729.




