Co-op Updates

eptember already, and our friends will be coming back soon.

We hope they had a great summer.

The primary responsibility of the Co-Op Board of Directors is to preserve, protect and enhance the common elements of our community.

What the Co-Op Can and Cannot Do –

Comments are often heard such as, "Why doesn't the Co-Op do something about ...(that)... or The Co-Op doesn't care about...(that)... or they don't do anything around here!" I would like to clarify what the Co-Op (Cooperative) can and cannot do. The primary responsibility of the Co-Op Board of Directors is to preserve, protect and enhance the common elements of our community.

The Co-Op only has the authority to enforce published Rules and Regulations that have been adopted. The Co-Op directs the Community Manager to follow legal steps based on Florida Statutes when responding to Rule violations which can ultimately lead to the eviction of a resident who continues to violate Rules.

What the Co-Op and Community Manager cannot do is intervene in disputes between neighbors. Disagreements or problems between neighbors must be worked out between those parties. Unless a Rule is being violated, the Co-Op / Community Manager does not have jurisdiction to take action. If a Rule is being violated, it needs to be brought to the attention of the Community manager via a Non-Compliance form who will respond appropriately per the policies and procedures established by the Co-Op Board of Directors.

It is the desire of the Co-Op Board of Directors for all residents of Paradise Island to live in a safe and pleasant environment. To do so, it is essential for all residents to live "Cooperatively" in a spirit of harmony by making responsible and respectful choices. Thank you for doing your part in that endeavor. Also, Please... don't litter, and don't leave your trash / old furniture at the compound or other common areas around the community, the trash rules exist for our mutual benefit. There are volunteers that take things to the dump or consider using the recycling site on Starkey. Please report non-compliance to the office.


Largo Police Number, but are hesitant, YOUR BLOCK CAPTAIN can make the call for you. We prefer you call yourself because you have the information, but if you can relate it in detail to your captain, then please ask us to make the call.

I know you have been saturated with hurricane preparation warnings but I'm going to add some personal tidbits from experience.

I hear some folks underestimate the evacuation warnings of our area. As one who has lived and evacuated a devastating hurricane, Hurricane Michael 2018 in the Panhandle, being in a manufactured home is the worst place to be. So, that being said, we evacuated for Ian. Yes, is wasn't necessary, in hindsight. However....

My suggestion is if you plan on evacuating check out the list of places beforehand. The pet friendly places are limited. See if they are single story or have elevators. We were on the second floor. Having to haul all our stuff, dog crate, 2 dogs, cooler, etc. up outside stairs in the wind and rain was not fun. I don't know if single story rooms can be requested or not. We messed up our reservations and were scrambling. And don't lie about pets. We saw a family being evicted because they snuck 2 dogs into a non-pet room. They were furious they got busted! There is usually an additional fee or a daily and/or a cleaning fee. But there are not unlimited pet rooms in pet friendly places. To be continued.










PI Monthly Ladies Luncheon
