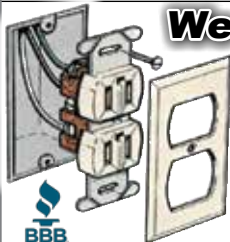

TREASURER MESSAGE

October begins the time when you can pay your HOA dues for Calendar Year 2024 dues are to be paid prior to February 1st in accordance to the By-Laws. Many people ask what the \$15.00 HOA dues does for them; these dues help pay for the negotiations with Cal-Am which will be coming up in short 2 years. These negotiations are not cheap and the more members the committee has standing behind them the more leverage they have. Paying dues also gives members a discount on tickets, in accordance to the By-Laws. A waiver was voted in for 2023 to give all residents the same price for one year. This waiver expires January 1st, 2024.

Please remember your HOA cannot force Cal-Am to do anything about individual concerns. Each resident is responsible for making their own concerns known to Cal-Am and working with them to come to a resolution per the Prospectus. Each resident is responsible for following the Prospectus that we agreed to abide by when we moved in. While your HOA is not responsible for the issues/concerns between the residents and management the HOA Board can help by discussing these concerns with Cal-Am Management and attempt to come up with a solution with them if the resident has given the Board a copy of the concern form and no resolution has been made within a reasonable amount of time. The HOA Board President talks to Cal-Am Management on a routine basis and brings up resident concerns and issues so they are aware. Remember the President nor the Board can make Cal-Am change anything they decide to do that is legal, within the boundaries of Chapter 723 and the Prospectus. The Board can reach out to the lawyer on retainer, when necessary, like for the parking issue, which Cal-Am was within their rights to enforce, even if we don't like it (which I do not!). The main purpose of the HOA as spelled out in the By-Laws is:

- A. Promote a good working relationship between the homeowners and the park owners.
- B. Represent the homeowners in their discussions with the park owners in matters pertaining to recreation, morale and group welfare.
- C. Exercise all rights granted to the association under the provisions of Chapter 723 Florida Statutes.
- D. Promote and develop social, recreational and educational activities for homeowners.

Please reach out to your Board Members if you have any questions or concerns, we will all do our best to help you. I became a Board Member to help our make community better just like the rest of the members.

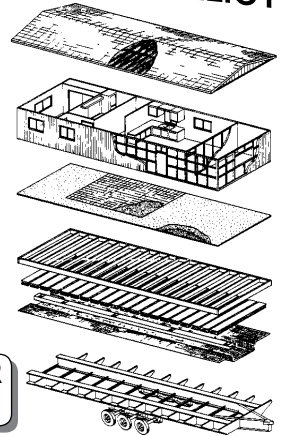

IITS Rules and Regulations



I have been asked by several residents to add a new section with the community rules and regulations. I am starting with the pool since it was just resurfaced and the deck repainted.

Swimming Pool (Observe all posted swimming pool rules).

- (a) A person age 18 or older must accompany all children who use the pool and are entirely responsible for their conduct in the pool, as well as their safety. Children seventeen (17) years and under may use the Community pool ONLY when accompanied by a Community Resident.
- (b) All persons must shower before entering pool.
- (c) Anyone using suntan oil or lotion must shower with soap and water before entering the pool or stay out of pool and may use pool lounges and chairs only when covered by a large towel. Waterproof sunscreens are permitted.
- (d) Persons in swimsuits are not allowed in Clubhouse, except to use the restrooms. Anyone entering the Clubhouse must towel off prior to entering.
- (e) A covering must be worn by all when going to and from the pool area.
- (f) There will be no diving or jumping into the pool.
- (g) Swimming pool will be open every day (unless closed for maintenance) from 8:00 a.m. until 10:00 p.m.
- (h) Running or horseplay will not be allowed in the pool area.
- (i) Beverages (alcoholic and non-alcoholic) may be consumed in the pool area. Glass containers are not allowed. Cans, paper or plastic containers only. This privilege **MUST NOT BE ABUSED**. All throw away containers are to be put in trash cans by their users.
- (j) No animals or food in the pool or pool area.
- (k) No toys, inner-tubes or floatation devices allowed in the pool or pool area. There Is an exception for life vest, inflatable water wings, baby inner tubes and "noodles".
- (l) Spa Capacity: six (6) persons. Absolutely no children seventeen (17) years of age or under are allowed in the spa.



- (m) Pool Capacity: sixteen (16) persons.
 - (n) No street clothes are allowed in pool.
 - (o) Children who are not toilet trained are not permitted in the pool unless they are wearing swim pants (“swimmies”). No children are permitted in the pool in diapers.
 - (p) Pool gates must be kept closed at all times.
 - (q) Smoking is not allowed in the pool or spa at any time
- **** Guest - A "Guest" is defined as a person who does not reside in the Community and whose stay in the Community does not exceed fifteen (15) consecutive or thirty (30) total days per year.
