





Halloween

ith the arrival of October 31st comes one of the world's oldest and most celebrated holidays. Originally derived from ancient festivals and religious rituals, today, many of the original celebration traditions continue to include costume parties, trick-or-treating, pranks, games and more. We thought it might be interesting to take a look at how Halloween is celebrated in different parts of the world.

Halloween originated during the Iron Age in Ireland and was called "Samhain" which in Celtic means "Summers End". The day is celebrated today much as it has been in the past. Bonfires are lit and all over the country, children get dressed up in costumes and spend the evening "trick-or-treating". After trick-or-treating, most people attend parties with neighbors and friends. At the parties, games are played, including "snap-apple," a game in which an apple on a string is tied to a doorframe or tree and players attempt to bite the hanging apple. In addition to bobbing for apples, parents often arrange treasure hunts, with candy or pastries as the treasure.

In Mexico, Latin America and Spain, All Souls' Day, is commemorated with a three-day celebration that begins on the evening of October 31. The celebration is designed to honor the dead who, it is believed, return to their earthly homes on Halloween. Many families construct an altar to the dead in their homes to honor deceased relatives and decorate it with candy, flowers, photographs, samples of the deceased's favorite foods and drinks, and fresh water. Often, a wash basin and towel are left out so that the spirit can wash before indulging in the feast. Candles and incense are burned to help the deceased find their way home.

A few African countries are well known for their witchcraft and voodoo practices such as Benin, Togo, Ghana, Nigeria and the Congo holding on to their own ancient traditions, thus somewhat having a connection with Halloween. There have also been many witch stories arising out of Madagascar where worshipping the dead is very common. Every year, the dead family member's body is exhumed, the family members elevate the corpse above their heads dancing and singing in circles. The corpse's clothes are then changed for new clothing and

the body is again wrapped in new sheets like a mummy before being reburied again until the following year's funeral anniversary.

Just as many countries celebrate Halloween, others don't celebrate or have even banned Halloween, frequently for religious reasons. For example, some religions prefer to celebrate the idea of life versus focusing on death. So this year, while you are carving your pumpkin, consider taking time to explore other fun and unique Halloween traditions around the world.






