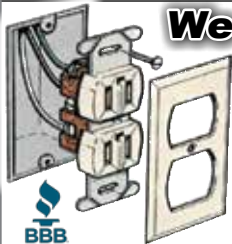

FOBS

Last year the Board replaced the keys to the Clubhouse and Pool Area with FOBS that increase the safety of all residents of Briar Creek. Remember to bring your FOB with you when you are going to the Clubhouse or Pool. Do not assume that someone will be there and open the door or gate – this defeats the purpose of issuing FOBS for security.

CLUBHOUSE/POOL AREA

After use of the Clubhouse or Pool Area remember to do the following:

- Relock any doors you dogged in the open position
- Turn off lights
- Turn off any fans you used – also fans on back deck by the pool
- Return any items you used from the kitchen and, if needed, empty the trash

If you would like to become involved at the board level, now is the time to think about taking that leap of faith. The pay isn't great and the job isn't always fun, but ultimately, it is rewarding when you make a positive difference in the lives of your friends and neighbors by enhancing their quality of life. Below is the timeframe for the election process:

October 5th: 60 Day notice of the election process mailed to property owners along with the Board Candidate Application for submission to Progressive

October 25th: Deadline for submission of the Candidate Application to Progressive

November 3rd: Ballot for Board Candidate election and Budget Proxy mailed to property owners from Progressive

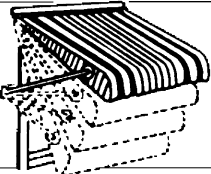

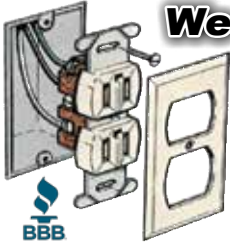

The Art Of Meditation

Meditation is the art of listening to the voice that speaks through the silence of prayer or focused centering. Learning to meditate is a tool that assists us to relax and be still or to relax so that abundant energy can flow without stress. When we learn to meditate the benefits can lower blood pressure, reduce emotional mental tension, relax muscles increasing effortless blood flow and oxygen to all parts of our body, feel guided toward specific actions in our life, and feel connected to our spiritual power. In a world that is moving faster and faster learning to meditate is even more essential for our well being. Too often we are busy with work, challenged in relationships, stressed with finances, as our overall health declines when we do not make the time for our health.

Learning to meditate is like setting our internal compass so it aligns with our desires and purpose in life. Meditation and prayer are like two parts of the whole. Prayer is speaking and evoking while meditating is the listening. Typically we are better at talking then listening. Simply ask a significant other.

There are two types of Meditation. Passive and active.

3 minute Passive Meditation.

1. Find a peaceful place. It could be anywhere
2. Sit in a comfortable position and close your eyes.
3. Focus on a peaceful light, peaceful thoughts, or the grace of divine spirit of your choosing.
4. Follow a slow breathing pattern. Breathing in joy and letting go of stress. Do this for at least 3 minutes each day.

Active Meditation

This is the art of mindful breathing while participating in activities. The gardener may feel a sacred connection to the earth, the hiker a profound connection to nature, the athlete may feel all stress disappear and feel an effortlessness tapping into their physical and mental potential. I have termed this Zen Tennis being an active tennis player for over 40 years.

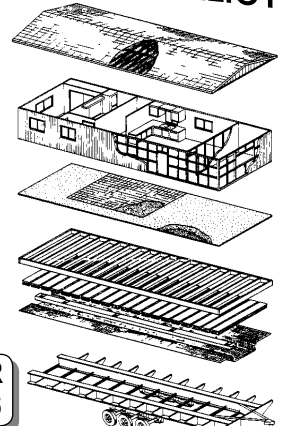

Halloween

With the arrival of October 31st comes one of the world's oldest and most celebrated holidays. Originally derived from ancient festivals and religious rituals, today, many of the original celebration traditions continue to include costume parties, trick-or-treating, pranks, games and more. We thought it might be interesting to take a look at how Halloween is celebrated in different parts of the world.

Halloween originated during the Iron Age in Ireland and was called “Samhain” which in Celtic means “Summers End”. The day is celebrated today much as it has been in the past. Bonfires are lit and all over the country, children get dressed up in costumes and spend the evening “trick-or-treating”. After trick-or-treating, most people attend parties with neighbors and friends. At the parties, games are played, including “snap-apple,” a game in which an apple on a string is tied to a doorframe or tree and players attempt to bite the hanging apple. In addition to bobbing for apples, parents often arrange treasure hunts, with candy or pastries as the treasure.

In Mexico, Latin America and Spain, All Souls’ Day, is commemorated with a three-day celebration that begins on the evening of October 31. The celebration is designed to honor the dead who, it is believed, return to their earthly homes on Halloween. Many families construct an altar to the dead in their homes to honor deceased relatives and decorate it with candy, flowers, photographs, samples of the deceased’s favorite foods and drinks, and fresh water. Often, a wash basin and towel are left out so that the spirit can wash before indulging in the feast. Candles and incense are burned to help the deceased find their way home.

A few African countries are well known for their witchcraft and voodoo practices such as Benin, Togo, Ghana, Nigeria and the Congo holding on to their own ancient traditions, thus somewhat having a connection with Halloween. There have also been many witch stories arising out of Madagascar where worshipping the dead is very common. Every year, the dead family member’s body is exhumed, the family members elevate the corpse above their heads dancing and singing in circles. The corpse’s clothes are then changed for new clothing and

the body is again wrapped in new sheets like a mummy before being reburied again until the following year's funeral anniversary.

Just as many countries celebrate Halloween, others don't celebrate or have even banned Halloween, frequently for religious reasons. For example, some religions prefer to celebrate the idea of life versus focusing on death. So this year, while you are carving your pumpkin, consider taking time to explore other fun and unique Halloween traditions around the world.
