HISTORY IN ST PETERSURG THE FLORIDA HOLOCAUST MUSEUM IN ST PETERSBURG

The museum was founded in 1992 by Walter and Edith Lobenberg. Both were German Jews who managed to escape the Holocaust and later relocated to the U.S. They were committed to ensuring that the stories and lessons of the Holocaust were never forgotten.

The museum originally opened in a small space in Madeira Beach, Florida, where it displayed a Holocaust boxcar used by the Nazis to transport Jews and other prisoners to the concentration and extermination camps. The original space was limited, so there was a need for a larger venue.

In 1998, thanks to community support and a growing collection, the museum relocated to its current 27,000-square-foot location in downtown St. Petersburg.

The Florida Holocaust Museum's core exhibition is "History, Heritage, and Hope," which covers the history of the Holocaust through personal stories, artifacts, and photographs. It has a mix of permanent and temporary exhibitions that highlight various aspects of the Holocaust and other genocides. The museum also owns an authentic WWII-era boxcar, which is on display as a poignant symbol of the Holocaust.

The museum places a strong emphasis on education. It provides teacher training, hosts educational programs, and offers outreach to schools. Their mission extends beyond just educating about the Holocaust, they aim to inspire people to stand up against hatred and prejudice in all its forms.

The Florida Holocaust Museum plays an essential role in Holocaust education in the Southeastern United States. By connecting the history of the Holocaust to the present day, it seeks to prevent future genocides and promote human dignity.

The Florida Holocaust Museum is a testament to the dedication of the Lobenbergs and the broader community to ensure that the atrocities of the Holocaust are never forgotten and that its lessons continue to resonate today.


