ear Fellow Residents:

Hurricane Season: LSR dodged another damaging hurricane this past month. The winds, rain, and storm surge were relatively benign. Please do not take hurricanes lightly. We are not yet in the peak of hurricane season.

Although the Tampa area has not been directly hit by a hurricane in over 100 years, it can still happen. Please register on the website disaster page and keep yourselves safe.

Water Usage: Water usage remains up this month. The pool is using fresh water to replace the evaporation (about 600 gallons a day) and we have more full-time residents in the park. However, the water usage seems to be increasing beyond what the board predicts even with these known increases. The board will be investigating leaks in the infrastructure and in the residents' homes. Please be advised that starting in the fall and winter, the board will come around to all homes and check for leaks inside the home. This check can be done from outside the home. In the event a leak is detected in the home, it is the responsibility of the homeowner to repair the leak.

Maintenance:

- A major power outage occurred in the Recreation Hall. A power panel caught fire and was destroyed. Outside contractors are being asked to evaluate and repair the damage. This repair could be costly and take several days or a few weeks depending on the cause and the repair. In the meantime, all activities in the hall have been suspended.
- Ron Markham and Andrew walked the entire seawall looking for any anomalies. None were found. The board is putting together several procedures including a seawall inspection procedure to ensure the park finds and corrects any problems early.
- A large branch fell from the oak tree by the entrance fountain. This was removed. Some damage to the fence resulted from the branch falling on the fence. The board will have the oak tree looked at by a professional to determine the cause.

Pool: Please remember smoking is prohibited inside pool fence.

Energy Use and Conservation: Electrical usage in the common areas is down 6% this year compared to last year. However, the cost of service is up 11.25%. The board expects that Duke Energy rates will continue to rise in the coming year.

Solar Power: The board is looking into the use of solar power in the park. This investigation will take some time and focus on the most impactful use of solar power for the residents.

- Financial information for August will be posted in the hall.
- The board has started the process of preparing the 2024 budget for the park. This will include the operating and reserve budget. A residents meeting will be held in early January to review the board recommendations.






