- Sign up for the **Alert Pinellas**, it's a free emergency notification service, online at www. pinellascounty.org/alertpinellas. This service provides multiple ways to notify you, such as landlines, mobile phones, email, and text messages, whenever an urgent situation such as flooding, arises in your location.
- There is also an application for your smartphone "Ready Pinellas."
- It doesn't hurt to check your homeowner's policy for coverage.
- If a tornado warning is issued you would be better off going to the clubhouse or pavilion bathrooms (be sure you have the codes written down) than staying in your mobile home, park model or RV.
