Happy Thanksgiving to our Canadian residents! (October 9th) Enjoy! Thank goodness, Hurricane Idalia did not come ashore close to us. We missed getting hit once again. We were blessed with only rain bands and some wind. However, the wind and storm season brings to mind that many of

us have been a bit negligent with potential flying missiles sitting outside our homes. Some residents have left items outside their homes that during the hurricane/storm season lay in wait to become flying missiles that could cause a great amount of damage. Please be mindful of these items, especially when traveling away for the summer months or even on a short vacation for several weeks. Our rules cover this in paragraph "d" under "Homeowners Responsibilities".

We have such a beautiful park with many nice trees. In recent years however, some of those trees have been taken out by disease or needs of our homeowners. If we continue to have trees removed without replacing them, our park will lose much of its grand beauty. I have asked Dave, Bev Richards and Richard Wolfe to put together a list of trees that the Board should consider as a one-for-one replacement tree policy whenever a tree from any of our "common areas" is removed. For clarification, our common areas are: the park central square (area containing the office, clubhouse, pools, shuffleboard courts, bocce court, pavilion and billiards building); the drive in along Orleans Way and the areas immediately around both Postal/Laundry buildings. I would like to recommend that residents possibly consider buying and placing one of these recommended trees within the common area in memory of a loved one. Such trees could also have a small plaque with the loved one's name placed at the base of the tree.

Additionally, residents may want to follow these same tree recommendations when considering adding a tree around their lot.

By replacing trees with new ones and even adding some to our lots, Clearwater Cascade will continue to be one of the most beautiful parks in the area.
