

PARK REMINDERS

Rules and Regulations-Homesites:

- 5. No storage of any kind shall be allowed under any mobile home unit, nor shall any resident park on his/her lot a travel trailer, motor home, boat and trailer, or larger than a ½ ton pick-up truck.
- 6. Fences or screening of any kind except as installed by management is prohibited anywhere in Sugar Creek Mobile Home Community.
- 11. Except for loading and unloading, all boats, utility trailers, travel trailers, motor homes, etc. must be removed from the park. Loading and unloading will be limited to eight hours. Repairs or remodeling is prohibited.
- 17. Cars are to be parked in the residents' driveway when not in use.
- 18. Parking vehicles on open lots or park lawns is prohibited. Overnight parking of any vehicle on the street is prohibited.
