

Then call me the next morning at (727) 787-3272 and I will note it in the daily log so that we can categorize the types of problems we are having, and the Sheriff can assign manpower to our park at times and places necessary.

Serendipity residents should ONLY CALL me during regular business hours which are 8:00AM - 5:00PM.

EASY PUMPKIN PIE

Ingredients

- 1 (15 ounce) can pumpkin puree
- 1 (14 ounce) can Eagle Brand Sweetened Condensed Milk
- 2 large eggs
- 1 teaspoon ground cinnamon
- ¹/₂ teaspoon ground ginger
- ¹/₂ teaspoon ground nutmeg
- $\frac{1}{2}$ teaspoon salt
- 1 (9 inch) unbaked pie crust

Directions

- 1. Gather all ingredients.
- 2. Preheat the oven to 425 degrees F (220 degrees C).
- 3. Whisk pumpkin puree, condensed milk, eggs, cinnamon, ginger, nutmeg, and salt together in a medium bowl until smooth.
- 4. Pour into crust.
- 5. Bake in the preheated oven for 15 minutes.
- 6. Reduce oven temperature to 350 degrees F (175 degrees C) and continue baking until a knife inserted 1 inch from the crust comes out clean, 35 to 40 minutes.
- 7. Let cool before serving.


