



About Joe Walker

here are so many life stories locked within each person it is a shame not to share them with family and friends. Here at Bayside Waters, we are beginning a new chapter of neighborly closeness which I believe will enrich all of us as we become more familiar with each other.

This article is a tribute to Joe Walker, a friend to so many. I would like to call him a Renaissance man as a special honor to a life well lived.

His mother was a Native American and his father was British. Being an only child, Joe spent time between his parents' home and his grandparents, which was one way he began travelling. He graduated from high school at 16, after which he worked on a cruise ship as a cabin boy and had other jobs that came his way. At one point he entered a military academy. He worked with his parents at their restaurant /gas station.

He later joined the Army and was stationed in Germany during the Korean war, and his job was working on codes. While in Germany he utilized his time off travelling throughout Germany and Europe.

When he came home and eventually married, they lived in Malone, NY where I think he was involved in restoration of the Alonzo Wilder home. That was a very interesting story.

There were so many interesting jobs, such as a used car salesperson which he didn't like, because as he put it, 'I had to lie, and I didn't want to do that to the customers. He went on to work as the director of the New York Travel and Tourism, and later he retired as dispatcher for the New York State Police.

This is not the end of his interesting experiences; I'm just running out of space.

Eventually Joe moved to Florida and bought a home on Pagoda Drive in our Japanese Garden, where, lucky for us, the next chapter of his life began.

He spoke of his joining community groups working to restore our beaches and planting grass and working on projects to clean the water to make it safe for the seabirds and fish, and of course us.

Life for Joe was commitment and loyalty. He was the true recreator of his life and the world around him. To know him was to realize his actions followed his words. He was filled with ideas and worthy commitments he held lovingly within his heart for years and years and offered creative ways to improve and encourage those programs already in progress, as with our very own social club. He at one time, was vice resident of our social club and kept on working with the rules and the prospectus to keep the park running smoothly.

Joe was a dedicated friend, anytime day or night he and Florence were there to give assistance to their friends or neighbors. Joe so often tried cheering others with a friendly joke, (he had a large repertoire of jokes), very often a warm smile was directed at you, just for you.

If you ever stopped by to say hello you were usually invited back ... He would say, "Anytime, anytime."

Wherever I saw him he always had a joke or a friendly word to say that lifted my spirits.

Joe will never be forgotten and will always be a source, at least for me, of remembered smiles, positive vibes, and many interesting life stories.





t age 20, Joe was a mess. He had been rebelling against authority for many years already. He was defined as a failure. He hadn't finished high school, as a matter of fact he had flunked four times. He became a street fighter, and he had 25 scars to prove it. And there was more—by 20 he had lost 30 jobs and been kicked out of the Marines. He was deemed incorrigible.

Nine years later, Joe was the valedictorian of Harvard Law School's 1967 graduation. He then went on to begin a career with the U.S. Department of Justice. He was considered one of the brightest of the young men employed there and seemed to have a great future before him.

Joe had turned his life around. He had pulled himself out of his long pattern of revolting against authority and was living a productive life. Several months after he was booted out of the Marines, Joe signed up for high school classes and he began reading constantly. Two years later he graduated with a 99 average. He went on to go to the University of California at Santa Barbara and was elected his senior class president. He graduated magna cum laude. He contacted the Marines and told officials there that he felt he had a blemish on his life and he wanted to make it right. He was allowed to reenlist and became a platoon leader and was given an honorable discharge after he had served his two years.

Time magazine described Joe's valedictory speech as the "year's most moving graduation address."

When asked about his turnaround, Joe said, "Once I'd made up my mind, it wasn't too tough."

And when asked about the inner change he had certainly gone through, he said, "[I] guess you could call it an inner resolution. I was just sick of being a failure." — adapted from The Guideposts Pocket Book of Inspiration, edited by Norman Vincent Peale




