Please be advised that effective 11/1/23, the management office will no longer accept paper checks or money orders for rent payments. We will require payments via one of the electronic payment methods we have available.

There are several convenient electronic payment options, which are all secure methods to make a rental payment: 1) Electronic Funds Transfer (EFT), 2) Resident Portal, 3) Western Union Bill Payments program and 4) CheckFreePay offered by Paylease/Zego.

If you are not currently signed up for one of our electronic payment methods, you will be required to do so as soon as possible. Should you have any questions or need any assistance in choosing your preferred electronic method of payment, please feel free to call the office at (727) 531-9149.

RoboCall & Text Messaging:

If you are not presently signed up for this service, I would highly recommend you sign up via the office, so you don't miss out on important management notifications related varying subject matter; park water shut off, Storm related messages, trash and holiday schedules. This is not mandatory, but I believe it would be extremely beneficial for every resident to be enrolled in this program.

Rent Due Date:

Please note that rent is due on or before the 1st of every month.

Presently the grace period for rent without late charges is the 10th day of the month. October 2023 will be the last month of this grace period.

Effective November 1, 2023, the grace period for rent will be changing to the 5th day of each month before late charges will be assessed to delinquent accounts. Late charges will start being assessed on the 6th day of the month.





Would You Like to Find a Paying Roommate?

For those of you who struggle to pay everyday expenses, and are thinking of getting a roommate; there is a non-profit organization that can help. It is called Home Share Pinellas. This organization matches those who have a room with those who need a room. Basically, they do the work for you. They do background checks, find out what kind of roommate you are looking for and then they look at the people who need a new home. You choose race, gender and age for your roommate.

After they find one or two people that match your needs, you are given the phone number so you can determine whether you want to meet. Then a face to face meeting takes place. You both agree on a rental price which is a month to month contract. This gives both parties the opportunity to terminate the contract with a 30 day notice.

For the first month only, the rent is split, 50% goes to Home Share Pinellas and 50% goes to the home owner. After that the home owner receives the entire amount. Don't forget, Down Yonder needs an application to be filled out by a new tenant plus a \$50 fee.

The woman I talked to is the program coordinator. Her name is Cathy Coomes, M.S. Her phone number is 727-945-1528. You can email her at cathy.coomes@homesharepinellas.org. I am now waiting for my new roommate through this program. Good luck in finding yours.



Make an inner resolution to change your life

t age 20, Joe was a mess. He had been rebelling against authority for many years already. He was defined as a failure. He hadn't finished high school, as a matter of fact he had flunked four times. He became a street fighter, and he had 25 scars to prove it. And there was more—by 20 he had lost 30 jobs and been kicked out of the Marines. He was deemed incorrigible.

Nine years later, Joe was the valedictorian of Harvard Law School's 1967 graduation. He then went on to begin a career with the U.S. Department of Justice. He was considered one of the brightest of the young men employed there and seemed to have a great future before him.

Joe had turned his life around. He had pulled himself out of his long pattern of revolting against authority and was living a productive life. Several months after he was booted out of the Marines, Joe signed up for high school classes and he began reading constantly. Two years later he graduated with a 99 average. He went on to go to the University of California at Santa Barbara and was elected his senior class president. He graduated magna cum laude. He contacted the Marines and told officials there that he felt he had a blemish on his life and he wanted to make it right. He was allowed to reenlist and became a platoon leader and was given an honorable discharge after he had served his two years.

Time magazine described Joe's valedictory speech as the "year's most moving graduation address."

When asked about his turnaround, Joe said, "Once I'd made up my mind, it wasn't too tough."

And when asked about the inner change he had certainly gone through, he said, "[I] guess you could call it an inner resolution. I was just sick of being a failure." — *adapted from The Guideposts Pocket Book of Inspiration, edited by Norman Vincent Peale*



A doctor-recommended exercise
