t is October so I am thinking we should talk about guests.

A guest is a non-resident whose stay in Teakwood Village does not exceed 15 consecutive day or 30 total days per year.

- 1. Resident MUST register overnight guests who remain in community 5 days or longer. Registration is to be done at Teakwood Village Sales office located in Teakwood East.
- 2. Guests are the responsibility of their resident host and MUST comply with the Rules and Regulations.
- 3. Management retains the right to reject any guest.
- 4. When conditions permit, guests will be allowed to use the park facilities. Guests under the age of 21 must be accompanied by resident host at all times.
- 5. A parking permit must be acquired at the main office for the overnight parking of guest vehicles in guest parking. No on street parking is permitted.

RECAP: Register guests, get parking passes for your guests and be here while your guests are here to make sure they follow the rules.





DINNING OUT

rillsmith at Countryside Mall 2539 Countryside Blvd #6, Clearwater; (727) 726-6061; Mon-Thurs. 11 am – 9 pm, Fri & Sat 11 am – 10 pm, Sun 11 am – 9 pm; grillsmith.com; reservations are recommended but not required. Grillsmith is on the upscale side with a pleasing understated décor. There is a fairly large covered outdoor dining area that would be nice in the coming months. The menu is eclectic and has an interesting array of appetizers, soups/salads, chicken/beef/seafood/pork entrees, flatbread pizzas, specialty drinks and dessert. The menu items are moderately priced. Grillsmith offers Premium Sides for \$5.90 each that you don't see on many menus: Au Gratin Potatoes, Jalapeno Mac N Cheese, Smashed Cauliflower. Your choice of regular sides of Mixed Veggies, Parmesan OR Blackened Fries, Mashed Potatoes, Sauteed Spinach or Jasmine Rice are included with most entrees.

Ten of us got together for lunch at Grillsmith, and while there was some duplication of choices, there was enough variety to give me an opportunity to review the overall quality of the meal. A few started out with one of the signature cocktails, a Toasted Coconut Painkiller. It was on the expensive side, \$12.50, but it was large, delicious and very potent. They did not skimp on the rum as some places do.

Some of the ladies opted to order an appetizer and salad or soup & salad as their luncheon entrée. Starting off, the Pub Pretzel (\$7 snack or \$11.90 shareable), a soft Bavarian style pretzel with Reef Donkey APA "Fondue" dipping sauce. The person who ordered it is considered by many, including me, as a pretzel connoisseur. She gave the dish an EXCELLENT rating, this was accompanied by a small Ceasar Salad (\$5) which was typical of what you would get just about anywhere. Next was the Caribbean Pumpkin Crab Bisque (\$5.95 cup, \$8.90 bowl). This is a rich creamy soup of pumpkin puree, blue-crab, toasted almonds, green onions & a dollop of cream. It was pronounced excellent by both diners who ordered it. One of the ladies also ordered the Blue Cheese Bacon Wedge Salad (\$6.50). The other had the Sesame Ginger Salad (\$12.90) which is mixed greens, red onion, bell pepper, orange segments, toasted almonds, sesame seeds and a ginger salad dressing, all topped by a pile of fried wontons. The salad was huge, very tasty and well worth the price.

Two diners ordered the Filet Tip Egg Rolls (\$14.90) which are deep fried egg rolls filled with marinated beef filet, shitake mushrooms, caramelized onions and blue cheese. The dish is served on a bed of shredded lettuce with sides of creamy horseradish and soy dipping sauces. There were no complaints! Three of us had the Chicken Marsala and Mixed Seasonal Vegetables (\$17.50) that also comes with a choice of sides. My chicken was a little overcooked but the other two said there's was very good. For sides, one ordered parmesan fries, one mashed potatoes and I ordered the Jasmine Rice. I can honestly tell you it is the best rice I have ever eaten. The manager, who visited our table, was kind enough to tell me that they use 2/3 to 1/3 cup ratio of



- 2 tb. maple syrup
- 2 tb. soy sauce
- 1 2 tb red wine vinegar
- 1 tb olive oil

Rinse chicken and pat dry, then add salt and pepper.

Cut chicken into cubes and put into marinade. Marinate for 3 hours and then grill for about 10 minutes on each side.


