

How You Pay Your Maintenance (HOA) Fee May Save You Time and Money

s we all continue to look for ways to save money and make our lives easier, have you considered how you pay your monthly Maintenance fee? There are several different ways in which payments can be made:

- ACH (Automated Clearing House) you can sign up to have your payment automatically transferred from your bank account every month.
- Mailing a check to the designated PO Box
- Taking a check directly to the Office (South Clubhouse)
- Using the 'Bill Pay' feature through your bank account
- eChecks are self-initiated debits from your checking account. You can choose to make a one-time payment or set up recurring payments. eCheck payments will be assessed a \$1.99 service fee for each transaction.
- Paying by credit card directly in One Source link through https://resourcepropertymgmt.com/ website. There is a 3.25% fee for processing.

At last count there are already 857 homeowners using ACH for their payments. For the ... continued on page 16



other 239 homeowners not using ACH, the office mails coupon books every year at a charge of \$3.75 each, costing Palm Hill \$896.25 each year. Automation is one of the easiest ways to save time and money since there are no checks to write, no going to the post office for stamps, no worrying about your payment being late or lost in the mail (late payments incur a \$25 late fee). By automating your payment, you will know it's made on time, no matter where you happen to be, giving you one less thing to worry about ... and saving you and Palm Hill some money, too!

Mailing Costs

There are two kinds of expenses in our beautiful community-- ones we have no control over, such as the sewer pipe repairs and maintenance of our pools. But there are a few expenses homeowners can reduce, and one of them is mail. Paper and postage add up. Opting out of mailing, and opting into electronic service, costs nothing.

Our park management is required to send us 3 notices per year: the budget, notice of annual meeting, and the ballot. One of these mailings sometimes fits in a standard business envelope at .63 U.S. postage, (because we have a meter that saves us .03) and 1.50 to Canada. The other two require a 9 x 12 envelope. Weight and distance determine exact postage, but for illustration, let's estimate the cost is 1.60 to a US address, 3.60 to Canada. At present, about 420 households have opted out of mail delivery, and get their notices via email. That leaves about 670 who are still receiving mail. Some folks do not use computers, but most do. So, here's an illustration of what we would save if 630 more households switched to email.

Let's assume that 330 of those mailings go to the US and 300 are sent to Canada or outside US:

 $.63 + 1.60 + 1.60 = 3.83 \times 330$ households = \$1,263.90

 $1.50 + 3.60 + 3.60 = 8.70 \times 300$ households = \$2,610.00

Then let's add in an estimated \$250 for paper and envelopes, for a total of \$4,123.90






