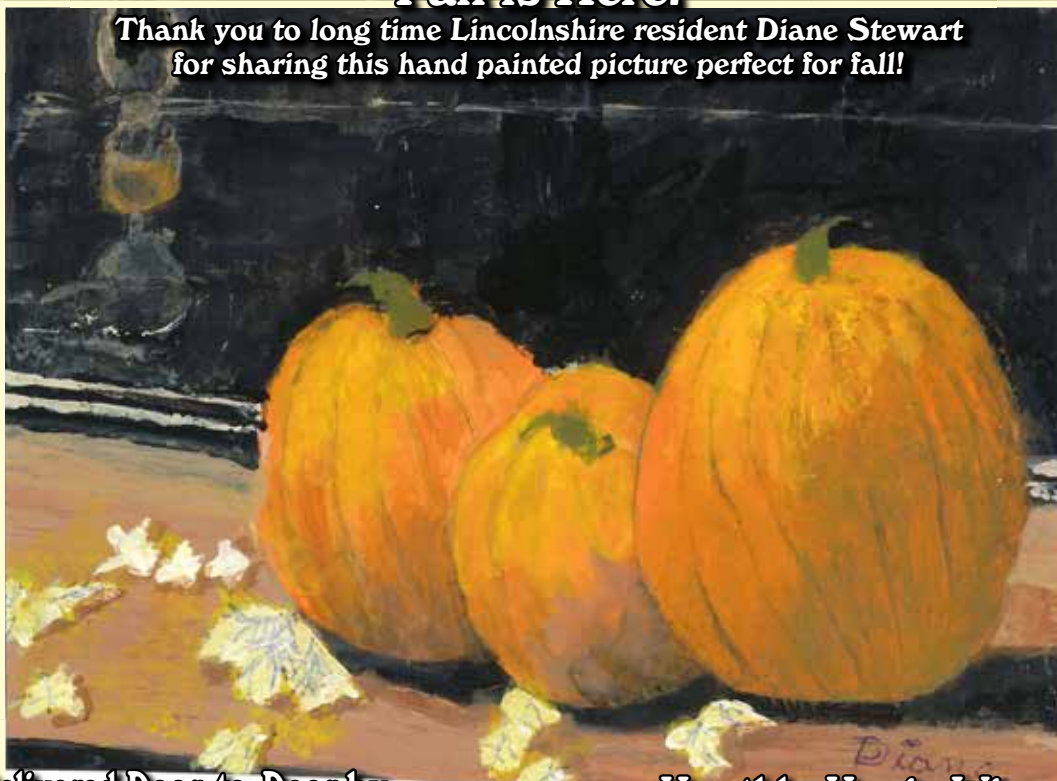

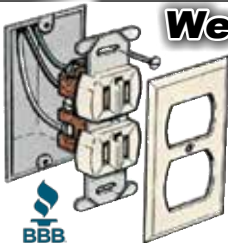

From the Board of Directors

Hello All,

Suzanne and I flew in on October 9th, and have been enjoying the warmth and sun after the cool and very rainy fall up north. I look forward to another peaceful and warm winter with friends.

It has been a very busy month in Blue Jay, with Sola Pool Resurfacing in this past week to power wash, fill, and reseal our pool pavers. They did a great job, and things are all set for another 2-3 years. The job was completed in one day so there was no need for a long term closing of the pool. Last week Mike Glogowski led a crew of Blue Jay carpenters in replacing the double doors on our storage shed. Mike and his helpers saved Blue Jay close to \$2000 dollars, and with finances as tight as they are right now any time we can save that type of money is a good thing.

Our landscapers are now on a biweekly schedule, which should make shrub trimming and weed control much easier. If you have any issue that needs addressing there is a large supply of reporting forms in the clubhouse. Fill one out and put "put it in the box."

Every time I think I have seen everything something new happens in Blue Jay. Two weeks ago a man, showed up in Blue Jay, started a chain saw, and cut most of the way through one of our palm trees before we could get to the site and stop him. He had already told 2 of the homeowners whose houses abutted the tree that he was charging them \$175 to remove the "diseased" tree. He fled when we called the Sheriffs, who have arrested him. We await a decision on whether we will get the cost of finishing the removal of the tree and replacing it. It just gets crazier every day in Blue Jay.

Remember, our November meeting is a "Members" meeting, and your presence or proxy is required to allow for a quorum to be achieved. Please plan on being there. You will receive a mailing which includes the budget and agenda immediately following the October 17th Board Meeting.

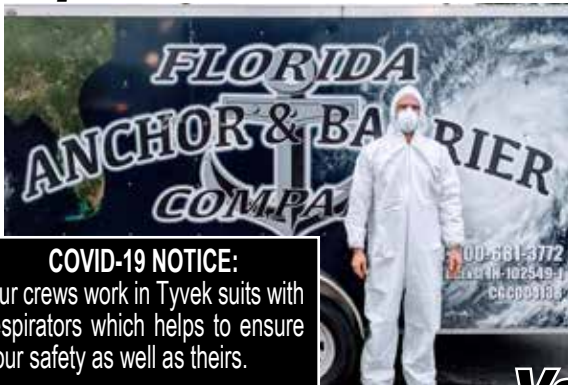

TOYS FOR TOTS

As the holiday season begins to draw near, our local Toys for Tots team is gearing up and is now operational. Since 1947, Marines have been making Christmas wishes come true for needy children.

This year's Toys for Tots campaign began on September 1st with the registration for families to receive toys. 2022 was a record-breaking year! Marine Toys for Tots (Worldwide) distributed an unprecedented 24.4 million toys, books, and game to 9.9 million disadvantaged children with the help of 50,000+ volunteers. Pinellas County alone distributed 34,001 toys to 9,019 disadvantaged children!

As of November 4th, Blue Jay Estates will start collecting new/unwrapped toys via the Toys for Tots collection boxes that will be located on the stage inside the clubhouse. For monetary donations (cash/checks), we ask that these be hand delivered to us at 172 Hickory Gate Drive. Checks should be made payable to "Toys for Tots – Pinellas County".

Toys for Tots in Pinellas County makes a difference in the lives of the less fortunate children of our community. This year, they expect the need to again be even greater than last and they are asking for our help. Though they accept toys for ages zero to 12, they always have additional toy needs for both girls and boys ages 10 to 12 and for children zero to 1.

The goal of Toys for Tots is that "Every Child deserves a Little Christmas," and we are asking you to help us send the needy children of our community a message of hope this

For the many volunteers who make Toys for Tots possible year after year, Toys for Tots embodies the true spirit of Christmas. The gift of a shiny new toy – something that most children take for granted – means to a needy child that someone cares, that he/she hasn't been forgotten, that Christmas hasn't passed him/her by.

Volunteer openings will be announced sometime in November. The volunteer needs will be for December 15 through December 23. **SAVE THE DATES** and be sure to attend Wednesday morning coffee hour or refer to the private (resident only) Facebook group “Blue Jay Estates of Palm Harbor - Private Group” for the latest information.

Kudos in advance to Joan Wingo #229 for allowing us to use her banister to hang a sign! When you see the sign as you enter Blue Jay, you'll know it's time to start dropping off new/unwrapped toys inside the clubhouse.

As far as the Toys for Tots Dinner goes.....mark your calendar for Saturday, December 9th. The Social Committee announced that Bill & Susan Pisano will be our hosts for this year's dinner/dance in celebration of the season and the generosity of Blue Jay Residents. Details on menu, price and entertainment will be announced sometime in November.

FEAST Food Pantry

The FEAST Food Pantry provides food and personal care items to residents in North Pinellas County. They distribute bags of shelf stable food based on family size which typically equates to a 3–4 day supply of food. They also provide perishable food staples such as meat, milk and fresh produce to their clients which helps them to create a balanced diet for their families. Additionally, their clients receive personal care items such as toilet paper, paper towels, toothpaste and other hygiene products not permitted for purchase under SNAP.

During a visit, they ask their guests “How many in your household?” They distribute the following portions to them: 1-2 guests = 18 lbs., 3-4 guests 25 lbs., 5-6 guests 44 lbs. Weekly, FEAST is distributing approximately 4200 lbs. of food.

At any given time, the most needed items are peanut butter, jelly, pasta and sauce, canned soups, canned veggies of all kinds, side dishes like rice, mashed potatoes, pasta salad and snacks like chips, popcorn, snack bars.

FEAST will also take Aldi, Publix & Walmart gift cards as this helps them shop for any items they need most.

Donation items can be left in the blue FEAST box located within the clubhouse on the stage.

Monetary donations / gift cards should be dropped off to us personally at 172 Hickory Gate Drive.

As always, please ensure donated items are unopened and not expired.

Thank you for helping us collect for FEAST with their most crucial items listed above.



WREATHS ACROSS AMERICA DAY

“Each December on National Wreaths Across America Day, our mission to Remember, Honor and Teach is carried out by coordinating wreath-laying ceremonies at Arlington National Cemetery, as well as at more than 2,500 additional locations in all 50 U.S. states, at sea and abroad.”



On Saturday, December 16, 2023, Wreaths Across America will be at Curlew Hills Memory Gardens to Remember and Honor our veterans through the laying of Remembrance wreaths on the graves of our country’s fallen heroes and the act of saying the name of each and every veteran aloud. A brief ceremony starting at approximately 11:30 am followed by the Wreath Laying at 12 pm until all the wreaths have been placed.

There is no limit on the amount of folks that can participate and although registration is not needed, if you would like to help Curlew Hills Memory Gardens lay wreaths at as many graves as possible, there is a sign-up sheet inside the clubhouse. Due to limited parking, this will help us coordinate car pooling among those who are attending the wreath laying ceremony. Unsure if you are available to attend that day, no worries. Again, registration is not needed so even if you decide day of, you are still welcome to participate.

In July of 1980 Jim and Peg McConnell found Blue Jay Estates and bought lot # 217, picked out a model had it built and moved in permanently in 1981. Jim passed away in 2009 so that leaves just me, Peg McConnell the only original homeowner left here in Blue Jay. So, after 43 years living here, I can truthfully say “been there done that.” I have seen so many happenings and changes in Blue Jay over those 43 years, some being good and others not so good, along with happy times and sad times.

On Saturday night January 20th, 2024 I will be hosting a “Blue Jay History” night at the clubhouse from 7-9 pm for anyone who is interested in some of the 43 years of history of Blue Jay. I have paperwork and stories of some things that have happened here in Blue Jay that I don’t believe anyone else has. Some of the paperwork goes back to the very beginning of Blue Jay including the survey of the land from 1976 and 1978 along with the minutes of the very first board of directors that the then owner Bobby Jacobsen held dated March 10, 1980. Since I did the last history night in 2021, I have a couple things that I could not share before as I did not feel at the time I could because of the sensitivity of the information but now I can. I will also have some pictures on display for you to see of a couple social events that happened in the past years and my home owners book you can see who owned your home before you and how many times it has been sold. It is truly a night filled with “Blue Jay History.”
