Treating Hearing Loss to Help Brain Health

ore than 6 million people in the U.S. are living with dementia. The condition causes loss of thinking abilities, memory, and other cognitive skills. Safe and affordable ways to prevent or slow the age-related loss of brain health are greatly needed.

Past studies have linked hearing loss to the development of dementia. So, treating hearing loss may be a way to slow or prevent brain problems. A new study tested whether hearing aids could help.

Researchers recruited nearly 1,000 older adults with substantial hearing loss. Half of them were given hearing aids. The other half received an education program about healthy aging. The researchers then measured cognitive decline over the next three years.

Participants who received hearing aids found that their ability to communicate improved. Those in the other group saw no improvement. Overall, both groups had similar rates of cognitive decline. However, people at increased risk of developing dementia, such as those

with diabetes or high blood pressure, benefited most from the hearing aids. Among these, the people with hearing aids had about half the rate of cognitive decline as those who had similar risks but didn't get hearing aids.

"Hearing loss is very treatable in later life," says Dr. Frank Lin from Johns Hopkins University. "We recommend for general health and well-being that older adults have their hearing checked regularly and any hearing issues properly addressed."

Medicare Season is Scam Season

From October 15 to December 7 each year, Medicare's open enrollment period allows beneficiaries to evaluate their healthcare coverage and make changes for the upcoming year. Unfortunately, this also means a spike in Medicare scams, as criminals exploit the heightened public attention and target beneficiaries who may feel overwhelmed with their healthcare choices. If you or a loved one are on Medicare, here are some tips to help you avoid scams during this open enrollment season.

How It Works

- You receive a call, text, email, or an in-person visit from someone posing as a "Medicare" agent or insurance provider.
- You may be urged to act quickly to avoid losing your benefits, pressured to purchase a limited-time offer that promises to save you thousands of dollars or enticed with a free gift.
- Or you could be told that Medicare is issuing new cards and needs to verify your information.
- They may request sensitive information, such as your Medicare and Social Security numbers or bank and credit card information.

What You Should Know

- Criminals often use caller ID spoofing to make a call appear as coming from Medicare or a trusted source.
- The scammers may sound professional, claim to represent Medicare, and have some of your personal information. But in reality, they're trying to steal your money, Medicare information, or your identity.
- Legitimate government agencies won't contact you to ask for your Medicare number or other personal information unless you've called 148004MEDICARE first.
- Medicare is not sending out new cards; anyone suggesting otherwise is lying to you.

What You Should Do

- Protect your information and never share your Medicare or Social Security number (or other personal information) with anyone who contacts you out of the blue by phone, text, email or shows up at your door.
- Be suspicious of unsolicited, aggressive, misleading, or too-good-to-be-true offers for a new Medicare plan, and don't be rushed into making a decision. You have until December 7 to enroll, and Medicare doesn't offer extra benefits for signing up early.
- Beneficiaries can safely compare plans and change enrollment by going to medicare.gov or calling 800 4633 4227.
- Each state also has a <u>State Health Insurance Assistance Program (SHIP)</u> that offers unbiased, one-on-one counseling to help you navigate the complexities of Medicare.
- Contact the <u>Senior Medicare Patrol</u> in your area to report Medicare fraud or abuse and to seek assistance.




