



### **HERE'S WHAT'S COOKING:**

picy Sweet Bacon Chicken Tenders: 8 thick slices bacon, 8 boneless, skinless chicken breast tenders, ½ c. brown sugar, and 2 T chipotle chili powder.

RECIPE

Preheat oven to 350 degrees. Wrap a bacon slice around each chicken tender, secure top and bottom of bacon with two toothpicks per tender.

In a shallow bowl, mix together brown sugar and chipotle chili powder. Roll bacon-wrapped chicken in mixture, then place on rimmed baking sheet. Bake for 35 minutes, or until chicken is fully cooked and bacon is crisp. (Place under broiler, if bacon is not crispy). Cool briefly on baking sheet, then roll in drippings and serve. Makes 8 servings.

### **SOCIAL SECURITY:**

ocial Security beneficiaries, who got big boosts in their cost-of-living (COLA's) the past two years as inflation soared, will likely see a more modest increase of 3% in their monthly checks next year.

That projected increase, is based on newly released government economic data, which would boost the average Social Security retirement benefit by about \$55.00 a month in 2024.

Estimates for the 2024 COLA are slated to be announced in October, and will be about 3 percent. This year's COLA was 8.7% with last year's being 5.9%. In the 2010's the COLA averaged 1.5%.

Social Security COLA's are tied to the Consumer Price Index for Urban Wage Earners and Clerical Workers (CPI-W).

An increase in the Medicare part B premium in 2024 would offset a portion of the COLA increase for Social Security recipients who have premiums deducted from their benefit payments. In the 2023 annual report, Medicare's trustees estimate the Part B premium would be \$174.80 a month next year, up \$9.90 from the current rate.






