Electrical Outage in Hall: At the end of August, a major fault in the underground electrical wiring from the office to the hall resulted in the 400a fuse panel being destroyed. The exact cause is still unknown, and the exact area of the fault is not known. It appears that the aluminum wiring from the office to the hall corroded and resulted in a short circuit. Three electrical contractors have been out to the park to evaluate the issue and supply quotes. As of this writing, we are still awaiting quotes to repair the damage. This will be a significant cost to repair. Rough estimates have ranged more than \$50,000. Trenching from the office to the hall will be required to replace the cables. Until this issue is resolved, the hall and spa are not usable. This is the primary focus of the board and has everyone's attention.

Water Usage: Three water leaks were found in the park: one in a common area and two on residents' side of the shut off valves.

Maintenance:

- The office building roof was recoated.
- Erosion was found by the dock area. This will be repaired by Andrew.
- One of the toilets in the men's room was gushing water. This will require a plumber to repair.
- All streetlights have been converted to LED. This has resulted in a significant savings in the streetlighting electrical costs.
- Symbiont has replaced the heating coil in heater no. 1. All heaters are now functional. This was repaired under warranty.

Pool: There was an issue this past month with a resident being in the pool area when the gates were locked. Anyone in the pool area can leave when the gates are locked. There is a knob on the inside of the gate that, when turned, will open the gate. There is a plate on the gate that will not allow anyone outside the gate to access the knob on the inside of the gate.

Phonebook: The new phonebook is in preparation. Please contact Bill Smith at lsrsecy2@ gmail.com if you have any questions or changes to your contact information.

Financial Status:

- Financial information for August will be posted in the hall.
- This year has stressed our reserves. Electrical issues, plumbing and sewer, including the lift station, new air conditioners, pool grate replacement, well repair, and fountain repair have already used more than \$52K in reserve funding. The hall electrical problem could push the total reserve usage over 20% of our total reserves this year. The board is evaluating the reserve requirements for the future and will address this during the budget process.

• The 2024 budget is being put together. The board is looking for unique solutions to mitigate the increasing costs we are experiencing. Some of the mitigations being implemented and explored are the use of LED lights for the streetlights, hiring a full-time employee to cut our grass as opposed to hiring an outside service, reducing the use of the well system to supplement the pool water evaporation, and continuing to reduce chemical and power requirements. Solar power is also being investigated as an alternative to Duke.

• Meetings on the budget will be held in January and February.

Shareholder Contact Method: The Board has implemented another method of contacting shareholders: Phone Call. Shareholders can now be contacted via your phone number on record using the service provider Call Multiplier.

Pets: Pets continue to be of concern. The Board has received complaints of pets off leash and pet owners not picking up after pets. Please contact Paul Burke at lsrdirector16@gmail. com with any pet related concerns.

Veterans Day – Remembrance Day – November 11

Veterans Day, originally celebrated as Armistice Day, was first issued on November 11, 1919, by President Woodrow Wilson a year after the end of World War I. Seven years later, in 1926, Congress adopted a resolution requesting that President Calvin Coolidge issue annual proclamations on November 11, making Armistice Day a legal holiday. In 1945, World War II veteran Raymond Weeks had the idea to expand Armistice Day to celebrate all veterans rather than

just the ones who died in World War I. He led a delegation to General Dwight Eisenhower, who was all for the idea. Weeks then organized the first Veterans Day celebration in 1945 in Alabama and every year since, until he died in 1985.

Canadians recognize Remembrance Day, originally called Armistice Day, every 11 November at 11 a.m. It marks the end of hostilities during the First World War and an opportunity to recall all those who have served in the nation's defense. The poppy is the symbol of Remembrance Day. In the run-up to Remembrance Day, replica poppies are sold by the Royal Canadian Legion to provide assistance to veterans. The reason that the poppy is worn for Remembrance Day is due to a Canadian physician and poet who noticed how quickly poppies had grown over the graves of soldiers who had died during the Battle of Ypres. This symbolism of the blood-red flowers was beautifully captured by Lieutenant Colonel John McCrae in his 1915 poem "In Flanders Fields" that was published in the London-based magazine named Punch.



- 4. Emergency Road Closures Road closures within Pinellas County
- 5. Know Your Zone Evacuation zones all mobile home parks are under mandatory evacuation during any evacuation order.
- 6. During and After a Storm Information on cleanup after the storm.
- 7. Disaster Assistance Information on insurance claims and FEMA

It is very important that any resident requiring assistance for evacuation, register on the "Special Needs" site. It is the only way that the County will be aware of their needs whether it is medical, mobility, or transportation, etc.

Our in-house LSR "Disaster Relief" form is to supply basic info to assist EMS and First Responders to perform search and rescue within the park during a severe weather event.
