From The President

any of you who have returned have complimented how great the park looks! Thank you to Harvey and all our residents for taking pride in their properties.



The Resident ID cards are available in the office if you have not picked yours up. These identify you or your guests when using the pool, chippers, shuffleboard, clubhouse, dumpster, or any other facet of the park. Please make sure your guests do use them also.

The County will come to discuss the sewer project in December or January. Please get your questions ready, as we will distribute forms ahead of time to submit your questions at the meeting so they can be easily answered. The County will have complete control of this project. The park and its residents will have none. The County will maintain all sewer lines and connections to your homes.

I would like to encourage all of you to vote in the upcoming annual election. The annual paperwork that you will receive by mail will include a statement regarding whether you want to fully fund the Reserve Budget. Our Budget has two parts: Operating and Reserve monies. Operating Budget is self-explanatory. The Reserve Budget covers buildings, roofs, pool, painting, windows, doors, etc. These monies can only be utilized for specific items. This money is not a funding pool that we can arbitrarily draw from.

Florida has passed a law stating that cooperatives must have 51% of votes (51% of the 311 units of the shareholders) to not fully fund our Reserve funds. That means everyone must vote.

What "fully funded" means to your monthly payments—you will pay:

- Your monthly maintenance fee + \$20.00 + \$258.00
- If not fully funded, you will pay your monthly maintenance fee + \$20.00

This is the most important vote that I can remember.

There will also be a vote as to whether you want an external audit of our books. External audits cost approximately \$6,000.00. Currently we have an internal Audit Committee comprised of shareholders with auditing experience. They perform a complete financial audit annually.

Florida has also changed the law regarding the driving of golf carts. All drivers under the age of 18 must have a valid driver's license or learner's permit to operate a golf cart. Please also be careful about allowing young kids to ride your electric bikes. We have had multiple complaints that young e-bike riders have created a very unsafe situation.

Josh Ross is a new real estate agent working in the park. He has been helpful in facilitating sales and closings. The staff have found him easy to work with.

We are looking forward to seeing all the owners returning to the park. A few have been trickling in and soon we will be full. Remember to come into the office and let us know you are here, and we can mark your file as returned.

ANNUAL MEETING AND BUDGET

All members should have received the first notice for the Annual Meeting. As stated in your first notice of the meeting, you needed to return your candidate form by October 31, 2023, if you were interested in being a candidate for the Board of Directors. Currently, we have three positions to fill. We have received two candidate forms in the office. By the time this newsletter goes out, it will be too late to send your form to the office to run for the Board of Directors.

Additionally, we cannot stress enough about getting your proxy sent in if you are not here in person to vote. One of the votes on the proxy is to either approve full funding or partial funding. The state now requires 51% of the total 311 members to approve the financial funding requirement for either Partial or Full funded reserves. The Board acknowledges that if 51% of the membership votes in favor of partial funding we will be able to maintain our \$20 increase for the 2024 budget. If 51% of the membership votes in favor of fully funding reserves, the owners will have an increase of \$278 in their monthly payment. The Board of Directors hopes the association members vote in favor of the partially funded reserves.

REGARDING RESERVES

It has been brought to our attention that many owners do not understand the concept of the reserve fund and pooled reserves. Reserves are designated to provide an annual percentage of the cost of replacement of the assets and/or major repairs of equipment, buildings or any asset that costs \$10,000 or more. Our community has pooled reserves, which means we have the right to use funds to repair or replace any item that is listed in the reserve fund as a category line item. This means we can use any amount of money to replace or repair an asset as needed from the total reserve amount, but only if that repair item is listed in one of the categories that funds the pooled reserves. Additionally, if the cost of the item being replaced or repaired exceeds the amount appropriated in the category that excess fund must be paid back to the pooled reserve, as well as rebuild the replacement cost of the items category that was exhausted financially. If you have any questions or need more explanation, feel free to see me in the office.

Tickets are now on sale in the clubhouse on Tuesdays and Thursdays from 11am to noon. Deadline to purchase tickets is Thursday, November 9th.






Which dog will you feed?



Reflections on hangovers and their cures

Tith the holiday party season upon us, it might be useful to reflect on the subject of the hangover.

and Cooking: The Science and Lore of the Kitchen, remedies for hangovers go back to ancient times. McGee says that as far back as medieval times, hair of the dog was being recommended by the medical school of Salerno: "If an evening of wine does you in, more the next morning will be medicine."

McGee says that the logic of this prescription is that the person who overimbibes is actually going through a slight withdrawal from drugs. That means, generally, that the longer you feel high and continue to drink, the worse you're going to feel the next day. There are probably millions who can verify this supposition. So it goes, that if you have a drink the next morning, you are giving the body what it got used to the night before, and you will feel slightly better from halting the withdrawal and mildly anesthetizing yourself.

However, this remedy comes with a caveat: You will at some time have to go through the withdrawal, so you are merely postponing the consequences by having another drink (one should also consider that repeating this over time can also lead to alcoholism).

Caffeine-laden drinks can reverse the effects of alcohol on the cranial blood vessels (alcohol enlarges them and caffeine shrinks them). This may help eliminate headaches due to alcohol consumption. Drinking liquids can also help restore fluid to the body, which has been lost due to dehydration when drinking. Eating carbohydrates can also help the body recover from the fatigue and malaise you may feel. Exercise may also help speed up the removal of the drug from the body. But generally speaking, and sad news for many, most hangovers must be treated by the passage of time.

You can get moving without going to the gym

If you want to get in shape, make it your business to move around more. This doesn't mean you have to do a "real workout," it just means that you need to make a conscious effort to make "action-enhancing" decisions. Here are a few suggestions for getting on the move:

- Take the stairs, not the elevator or escalator.
- After lunch, take a walk with a friend instead of sitting around the lunch table gabbing.
- Mow your lawn, and stop waiting for someone else to take care of it.
- Plant flowers.
- Play hide and seek with your kids.
- Take your dog for a walk.

The main point here is to move around more than your norm. If you're living a sedentary life, now's the time to break the pattern. Once you do, you'll feel your energy start to increase — and you'll be glad you did.
