SHORELINE PALMS HOME OWNERS ASSOCIATION NEWS

Residents, Our HOA met with Murex this week and we discussed several topics of concern and were able to confirm that all is well. As far as the Clubhouse renovations are concerned, it is on or slightly ahead of schedule. I stop in occasionally to observe the process and it is impressive. I will get some new pictures out to you shortly.

Let's go over some of the items we discussed:

- First, the plantings in your front garden beds. This process has slowed down due to the inability to obtain all the plants. They are proceeding with 50 plant batches. More are arriving each week and if you signed up, you will be receiving your plants soon. A special note on this topic all plantings were ordered and paid for based upon the original requests by residents. If you change your mind, it makes Murex responsible for the cost of the refused plantings. This is not acceptable! Also, if you find that even with constant watering, a plant is dying, please take photos and document this information, it will be given to the plant nursery to replace them. Also, if you have a neighbor who has plants that are not getting watered, be a good Samaritan and take time to add water to these new plantings.
- We talked about people speeding in the community and how this has become an epidemic. We feel that if we don't do something, we are guilty of not addressing a dangerous situation. In this instance, we are looking at getting electronic speed signs that will monitor and display the speed of vehicles passing through the streets. We don't have the authority to issue speeding tickets, but knowledge is a powerful tool. It appears that some people just don't care. We are on the path of a serious injury or death.
- We addressed the Pickle Ball courts, exercise room, and outdoor kitchen. Murex has had conversations with the general contractor, and they believe these projects should be moved into the next calendar year. All efforts at this time will be put into getting the clubhouse ready for our residents to enjoy. We believe this is the right thing to do. The installation of a Hot Tub is now in question for several concerning reasons. More will come on this subject.
- We asked to have the signage at the 12100 Seminole Blvd gate updated to show the change in name of our community and to give explicit instructions on how to enter our park.

I want to take this opportunity to thank Management in conjunction with the cooperation they are putting forth working with the HOA that represents all our residents. I have been doing this for many years and there has been some contentious times but other than issues out of their control, Murex and the contractors have been upfront and open minded to our concerns.

HOA Monthly Meetings

Due to the renovations in the Clubhouse, we may have to postpone the election of HOA Directors. The normal procedure is to nominate in November, elect in December, and install elected Directors in January. This requires that we notify all residents that have paid 2023 HOA dues

so they have an opportunity to vote for the candidate of their choice. Without access to the Clubhouse, this is not possible. We have reviewed the HOA Bylaws to ensure this is legitimate and appropriate. This has been confirmed. At least (4) Directors are up for reelection, so this is important. Further information is forthcoming.

HOA Dues

It is more important than ever to attend the HOA meetings which will resume in the Fall. There are a lot of new residents moving in or have recently moved into our park. You will get first-hand information HOMEOWNERS from the President, as far as he knows it, about the happenings and ASSOCIA

decisions made by the new owners. By paying your \$10.00 a year HOA dues, this gives you the opportunity to participate in the meetings, ask questions, and nominate and elect officers and other Board members by ballot vote in December. Only members may vote with one vote per household. Board members are installed at the first meeting in

January. Meetings are usually held on the first Tuesday of the month from October through April. 2024 memberships are now being sold. Sue Sears has the necessary paperwork at her house. By paying your membership dues you will receive a membership card that you can show at the attendance table as you come to the meeting. The \$10.00 yearly membership is for the whole household, not just one person. Call or see Ray or Sue Sears to arrange payment of your dues and become a member of the Home Owners Association. ... continued on page 25
