Welcome back to all our seasonal residents. This year is flying by.
This summer has seen a number of repairs to park equipment. As many of

you know, the adult pool began to have problems early spring when it began losing water. We had Red Rhino out to make repairs inside the pool. Then the collector tank cracked open and the adult pool was losing water a second time. This collector tank turned out to be a bigger and more expensive replacement that will not be completed until 2024, however Pool Works was able to make a temporary fix that is currently holding. The equipment worked well until August, when the heating/cooling devices for the pools and spa along with their 13 ½ year old compressors died. There are 6 of these that we replaced and so the pools are doing fine for now.

Recently, the air conditioning in the Library/Exercise Room and the filing/office kitchen area are not working. At current, we are receiving bids from three companies to replace them. So, the theme of this year has been some hefty repairs. Fortunately, some of these expenses are covered in our Reserves. The unfortunate news is that they are not all covered.

The summer sun impacted the card table area of the Library and new window shades were purchase and installed. You will also notice new parking stops and painted parking stripes upon your return.

We also took time out for lots of fun this summer and I would like to thank the "Summer Tribe Ladies" and their helpers for putting together so many great activities.

Now budget season is here again. As I write this, a Budget Workshop is being held later this week to discuss next year. Also, this week we will be hearing from Grant Escobar from Level Engineering regarding the Canal and possible solutions that lay ahead for us.

It will soon be time to elect 3 Directors for next year. If you are interested in running for the Board, I would encourage you to attend all meetings to get up to speed on Clearwater Cascade HOA business. We need those who are interested in being on the Board to be knowledgeable and have the best intentions for our park.

hanksgiving —We are wishing everyone a very Happy Thanksgiving! Office Closure – The business office will be closed Thursday, November 23rd and Friday, November 24th for the Thanksgiving Holiday. We will reopen on Monday, November 27th.

If air in the tank is full, you may not hear anything until the air pressure is used and you will hear it come on as you fill your tire. Be sure to turn the switch back to the off position!


Emergency Contacts – The office has had a few situations where we needed to get in touch of next-of-kin and did not have an emergency contact form on file. If you have not filled one out, please turn one into the office.

Share Certificates – If you do not have a Trust or next-of-kin on your Share Certificate, you may want to think about adding someone to your Share. If something happens to you, it will take a lot longer to go through probate for the heir. If you have any questions, contact the office.

CLEARWATER CASCADE HISTORY

learwater Cascade Mobile Home Park is not an historical landmark but it is home to a few hundred people.

On July 12, 1994, MLH Income Realty Partnership of NY sold three parcels of land, five buildings, two pools, and shuffle Board courts to the CWC

Homeowners Association, Inc.

CWC was originally, a family mobile home park and the residents banded together to form the corporation in order to become a resident owned park.

According to long-time resident, Gwen D'Epiro, her husband was out shopping when he overheard that the park was being sold. He hurried back to the park and contacted John Ferraro, president of the board of directors. John called a meeting and presented a scenario. If residents were willing to "put" up a sum of money, they could purchase the park and make it a resident owned 55 and older park. This money would purchase them a share in the corporation and they would be guaranteed this money returned to them, should they decide to move. John was able to get 105 people to invest and they were able to make it all possible.

Gwen is still living in our park and is a wonderful storyteller. Many thanks to her for sharing this interesting bit of history.

THANKSGIVING TRIVIA



Happy Thanksgiving



- Thanksgiving was originally celebrated in mid-October. The first Thanksgiving celebration wasn't in November at all. In fact, some historians suggest it was held in mid-October, similar to the present-day Canadian Thanksgiving. It was President Lincoln who set the November date in order to coincide with the Pilgrims' landing on Plymouth Rock.
- Thanksgiving was once celebrated on the third Thursday in November. Decades after President Lincoln declared Thanksgiving a national holiday, President Roosevelt decided to mix things up by moving it up a week, to the second to last Thursday in November, in 1939. By doing this, he added seven shopping days to the holiday season, but the change upset football coaches whose weekend Thanksgiving games were switched to regular weekday games. It also messed up printed calendars for years. After much consternation, Thanksgiving returned to the last Thursday in November in 1942 and has been held then ever since.
- The tradition of football on Thanksgiving was started by college teams. The tradition of football on Thanksgiving began in 1876 with a game between Yale and Princeton. The first NFL games were played on Thanksgiving in 1920 (more on that game in a minute).
- The first professional Thanksgiving Day football game was played in 1920. More than a century ago, when Thanksgiving Day fell on November 25, six football games took place, according to the Pro Football Hall of Fame. Non-league teams like the Elyria Athletics went up against league teams in games that counted in the standings. Football fans, whip these stats out from the results of that year's games, and you will WIN at table talk:





- Chicago Boosters (27) vs. Hammond Pros (0)
- All-Tonawanda (NY) (14) vs. Rochester Jeffersons (3)
- Benjamin Franklin wanted the turkey to be the national bird. In a letter to his daughter, Benjamin Franklin wrote, "For my own part I wish the Bald Eagle had not been chosen the Representative of our Country...For the Truth the Turkey is in Comparison a much more respectable Bird." Although Franklin didn't get his wish, his letter did inspire a song in the Tony-winning musical 1776, about the drafting of the Declaration of Independence.
- The first Macy's Thanksgiving Day Parade featured Central Park Zoo animals. The
 Macy's Thanksgiving Day Parade was originally called the "Macy's Christmas Parade"
 to kick off the holiday shopping season. Held in 1924, the first parade included monkeys,
 bears, camels, and elephants borrowed from the Central Park Zoo instead of the traditional
 character balloons we know today.
- "Jingle Bells" was originally a Thanksgiving Day song. Before becoming a Christmas holiday anthem, "Jingle Bells" was an 1857 song titled "One Horse Open Sleigh," and its composer, James Pierpont, intended it to be a Thanksgiving Day song. But it became so popular around December 25 that in 1859 the title was changed to "Jingle Bells"—and the rest is history!




