

Please reach out to the Office to make arrangements for additional parking and guest accommodation assistance and questions.

Decorations bring so much joy to everyone despite how old or young you are. Please check your outlets to make sure they are fitted for outdoor use, please tuck away cords so landscapers do not cut them.

Amazon and other web retailers have a section to be completed with delivery instructions before you place the order. Please utilize this feature to leave instructions for the driver to ensure your packages are left safe.

With the Holidays approaching I am sure there will be some projects to beautify your homes. Open top trash containers fill up really fast and everyone can help manage the trash and debris by breaking down boxes and throwing away only the items the open top container is intended for. Contractors are not allowed to dump construction debris and have to haul it away. The space is very limited and it would be great if you could please communicate to your contractors prior to the project start.

We have a great maintenance team and they really work hard to keep Americana cove looking as beautiful as it can be. Please be mindful and please pack your garbage and place it into the containers with lids. It would be great if you could avoid placing garbage in gondolas overnight as wild animals tear the bags and scatter garbage. It is the little things we do that keep overall appearance of the community so beautiful.

And please remember to be safe. So many thefts happen during festive season as everyone has too much on their minds and leave cars and homes unlocked. Remember to stay vigilant and aware of your surroundings.

President's Message

an you believe we are nearing the end of yet another year? Currently, I feel we are on the right path with a Board of Directors that works very cohesively with one another and is constantly putting the affairs of Americana Cove at the forefront.

We are in a great position with our new manager, Vita Blough, who is not afraid to tackle anything and really helps to move things along. We have a phenomenal staff with Chrissy and Tracye in the office answering the millions of questions and assisting current and new

homeowners. Maintenance staff is working smoothly and our Gate staff is here for you. It takes a village and that village would not be complete without the many volunteers and the staff we have working hand in hand with our Board to keep Americana Cove a premiere 55+ community!

Our biggest challenge at this time is still the accounts and misunderstandings about monthly maintenance fees. Fees are due on the 1st of the month. Mailing it after the 1st means it could reach the account after the 10th giving you a \$25 late fee and a \$15 charge for a notice of late assessment. When you send a check, it goes to a lock box in Miami. The lock box is opened by banking officials, not by Associa, who must rely on the bank to tell us when they opened the lock box and scanned your payment. Mailing in your payment can take 10 to 15 days or longer to post to your account. Direct Debit or ACH payments come out when scheduled (generally the 5th of the month) and with Direct Debit or ACH you will not have late fees. The safest system is to do Direct Debit or ACH. This <u>does not</u> give access to your bank account as I hear so many residents share this concern. Please consider visiting with us if you need more reassurance in switching over to Direct Debit or ACH. Chrissy, Tracye, and Vita are all very capable to help you set up the paperwork to go to this payment method. Remember, payments are no longer accepted in the office.

Another item that needs to be addressed is that many residents have golf carts to assist in getting around the community. You must have a drivers license to operate a car or a golf cart. Children should NOT be driving golf carts. Please don't allow your grandchildren to get around the community in your cart, you will be held responsible. We want everyone to stay safe and alert. Thank you for following the rules of the road.

We are excited to see Fall and realize how busy things will be getting here as residents return for the "colder months". Again, please talk with the members of the Board or with the Office Staff to resolve issues, ask questions, check your account, or learn some of the new systems that are available. Thank you!

How high will interest rates climb?

ccording to the National Association of Realtors (NAR), mortgage rates could rise to 8% in 2023, but predicts that they will lower to 6% by March or April 2024. The association noted that high interest rates are harming home sales nationwide.


Vespers has been a Cove activity since 1963. We encourage attendees to suggest speakers which range from lay speakers, missionaries, and pastors from a variety of religions.
