

HISTORY OF ST PETERSBURG

S t. Petersburg, Florida, is a city with a rich and colorful history. Here are some interesting historical facts and highlights about this vibrant city:

Founding and Name: St. Petersburg was founded in 1888 by John C. Williams, who purchased the land and envisioned it as a resort destination. He named the city after his hometown of St. Petersburg, Russia, hoping to attract Russian investors to the area.



The Sunshine City: St. Petersburg is often referred to as "The Sunshine City" because it holds a Guinness World Record for having the most consecutive days of sunshine—768 days from 1967 to 1969.

First Commercial Airline: In 1914, the world's first commercial airline, the St. Petersburg-Tampa Airboat Line, began operating between St. Petersburg and Tampa. It used a Benoist flying boat, marking an important milestone in aviation history.

The Vinoy Renaissance St. Petersburg Resort & Golf Club: This historic hotel, built in 1925, symbolizes St. Petersburg's elegance and charm. It has hosted celebrities and political figures throughout its history and played a significant role in the city's social life.

The Salvador Dalí Museum: St. Petersburg is home to the Salvador Dalí Museum, which opened in 1982. It houses the largest collection of Dalí's works outside of Europe, including many of his famous surrealist pieces.

The Pier: The St. Petersburg Pier, initially constructed in 1889, has undergone several renovations and rebuilds over the years. The current iteration, known as the St. Pete Pier, opened in 2020 and is a popular waterfront destination with restaurants, shops, and recreational areas. The Arts Scene: St. Petersburg has a thriving arts community with numerous galleries, theaters, and museums. The city hosts the annual St. Petersburg Festival of the Arts and is known for its vibrant mural scene.

The St. Petersburg Shuffleboard Club: Founded in 1924, this club is the world's oldest and largest shuffleboard club. It continues to be a hub for shuffleboard enthusiasts and hosts tournaments regularly. The Sunshine Skyway Bridge: The Sunshine Skyway Bridge, connecting St. Petersburg to Sarasota, is a vital transportation link and an architectural marvel. The current cable-stayed bridge was completed in 1987 after the original bridge collapsed in a tragic accident in 1980.

FROM MANAGEMENT

****DO NOT FLUSH WIPES-NO SUCH THING AS A FLUSHABLE WIPE****

OWING-Although mowing your yard is very important and greatly encouraged. SUNDAYS at Gateway are still a time of peace, and it has always been a rule at Gateway

NO MOWING OR USE OF POWER TOOLS ON SUNDAYS.

Our Residents have six days a week to clean up and make home improvements, but please consider your neighbors on Sundays. Now, this doesn't mean you can't do work, Just no power tools.

That's all we ask.

TOWING-Again there seems to be some confusion. The towing rules have not changed at all since they were put in place 5 years ago.

- (1.) STREETS-No Parking on the street after 11 pm
- (2.) GRASS-No Parking on the grass ANYTIME
- (3.) EMPTY LOTS/PADS- No Parking ANYTIME
- (4.) CLUBHOUSE/LAUNDRY- No Parking overnight MON-THURS without Parking Pass

Any of these will get your vehicle towed without hesitation. These rules have been given to the Residents many times over the past 5 or so years, same as the tow company, so getting mad at the office or the tow company is not productive. Just be mindful of the Rules that Gateway Residents Voted for years ago when Parking was way out of hand.

OVERFLOW LOT- It has come to the office's attention that many residents who agreed to keep the area mowed and weeded around their vehicles are not doing so.
