our HOA has been very busy communicating with Legacy on your behalf on a number of issues. Monitoring and inputting



ideas for their Capital Improvement Plans has taken up most of our time and we are happy to report that the Hacienda renovations should be complete by mid-November or earlier. As promised, this will include, but is not limited to, new flooring, total washroom renovations including wheelchair access in both men's and women's washrooms, new kitchen cabinets and appliances and some outside painting. We are very happy to report that a new sound system including a new digital board with a separate Bingo package, new hand-held mikes, over ear mikes, ceiling speakers and even a new drop-down screen with projector will be installed. After much discussion the roads resurfacing will be limited to the parking lots and Lakeside roads. You should notice cameras inside and around the public spaces and some new signage.

Legacy has confirmed that they will be installing a new sound system in the Hacienda. In order to ensure proper handling of this system we encourage the following groups: Men's Club, Women's Club, Entertainment, Bingo, and Dances to think of identifying a person from their group to undergo some initial training on this system and be available during their activities to handle this new sound system. Anyone else interested in taking on this responsibility should contact Brad Kalway who will lead this work group.

Legacy is also working on providing an automated system for the Residents to have access to an Emergency number in off hours and they suggest that Residents needing some plumbing work deal in preference with Rooter Man. This company has established a good relationship with both Legacy and many Residents to date.

The November HOA meeting date will be announced via Clubhouse bulletin boards and other means once a date is established. The completion date of renovations and other planned activities are the two main factors affecting this date, but be assured that we will be holding a November meeting and it will be in a renovated Hacienda Clubhouse!

We are considering Tuesday, Nov 14th, 7:00 pm at the Hacienda for our next HOA Board meeting, but please check the Notice Boards at Clubhouses to confirm the exact date; this is a tentative date at this time. All residents are invited to attend, but it's an HOA Board meeting, not a Resident meeting, so only questions pertaining to the Board's agenda will be accepted at the end of the meeting.
