Then add 22300 to your contacts as PI One Call so you will recognize who the text is from. If you do not currently receive One Call phone messages to your cell phone and would like to receive text messages, please complete the Contact Information Form that is available at the office or on our PI Website. After you receive your first One Call Phone message, switch to text messages by following the above steps.

All this and more consumes many, many volunteer hours. Note: Pinellas County is becoming very expensive to live in and our rates are still well below similar communities.

Lock your golf cart and block it's exit, if possible.

FYI, Largo PD has a Facebook Page. Electric bikes are now a HOT ITEM to steal. Don't leave these available at any time. Keep inside if possible or lock with a heavy duty U lock. Register the serial number, so if stolen, resale can be checked on various sites.

HOA Message

Why you should join the FMO.

The Federation of Manufactured Owners of Florida (FMO) is located in Tallahassee, Florida. Their sole mission is to look after the interests of the mobile home communities. They have a paid lobbyist that monitors legislation affecting our parks, our subdivisions, our homes and our lives here in Florida. They focus primarily on that dealing with manufactured housing but, along with our partners, also track matters related to many issues that ultimately affect our members.

Their lobbyist monitors and reports on the issues presented in Tallahassee. They also meet regularly with Legislators and staff to promote FMO's viewpoints and member's interests.

Things that they could have used our help on, as members, was by contacting our local state representatives, was a bill that died in the Senate that would have leveled the playing field as such. It took the unfair advantage that park owners have in setting rents over tenants and makes it the same as for HOA's condominium and cooperative disputes. This bill died in the Senate due to lack of support. The FMO asked for people to contact their representatives, but with a small membership the word did not get out.

On the bright side House Bill 321 which would have allowed tiny homes in mobile home parks, such as ours, was defeated by a joint effort of several groups led by the FMO.

There are legislative battles every day, even when the legislature is not in session. This is the time they draft bills for the next session and it is important for the FMO to participate in these off times. They can do a lot more with your help. To join, join go to FMO.ORG

Membership has its advantages, and offers many valuable services to members such as:

- Dedicated lobbyist in Tallahassee,
- "Legal Ease", advice for residents and HOAs from FMO's Legal Council
- The association of others who are willing to come together to fight for your rights.
- The cost for all of this for an annual membership is only \$30, or \$75 for a three-year membership, which is a fraction of its worth.






VETERAN'S CORNER

Tormer Thunderbirds Commander, Retired NFL Player **♦** Die in New York Plane Crash:

Russ Francis, who played a total of eight seasons with the New England Patriots, died Sunday in a plane crash outside of Lake Placid, New York, the team confirmed Monday.

The 70-year-old Francis was a passenger on an aircraft that



Francis was the president of the scenic tour company Lake Placid Airways, which he recently purchased. The company noted that Francis has been a pilot himself for 49 years, has owned an air charter company in Hawaii and also "owned and piloted his P-51 Mustang and Hawker Sea Fury British fighter."

Francis was drafted by the Patriots in the first round of the 1975 NFL Draft out of Oregon. Francis placed his first six seasons in New England before going on to join the San Francisco 49ers. Francis went on to win a championship in Super Bowl XIX during his time in San Francisco. The former tight end finished his NFL career with a three-year stint back in New England. He was a three-time Pro Bowler and a two-time second-team All-Pro selection. Francis finished his career with 393 receptions for 5,262 yards and 40 touchdowns. He remains third in Patriots history in touchdowns and receiving yards among tight ends, trailing only Rob Gronkowski and Ben Coates.


