The 2023-2024 Ladies Golf Lessons will begin November 5.

For the past 17 years at Palm Hill Country Club Golf Course, Caroline Zimmerman and her longtime best friend Claire Longman offered free golf lessons on Sunday afternoons, creating a community of new golfers and future members of the Palm Hill Golf Course and the Ladies Golf Association.

Caroline will again offer lessons this season on Sunday afternoons.

Claire passed away Oct. 4, 2022 and is often remembered by Caroline in her classes, as well as by those who learned the game of golf from Caroline and Claire over the years. Both women helped students forge new friendships in class, and taught aspiring golfers new skills to enjoy in their retirement years.

With professional careers in physical education and a devotion to teaching and improving lives through physical activities and

sports, Caroline and Claire both received honors in their fields, and continued their passion for golf at Palm Hill. Both were inducted in the Wittinberg University (Ohio) Athletics Hall of Honor for their professional and academic contributions.

Here at Palm Hill, both earned trophies in the Palm Hill Ladies Golf Championships and contributed their professional expertise to the many golf tournaments and events held here. Both served as leaders in the Ladies Golf Association and on the Palm Hill Golf Committee, of which Caroline is still a member.

Caroline first came to Palm Hill in 1972, visiting her friend, Betty Dillahunt, who was head of athletics at Wittinberg University and an honored pioneer in women's sports. It was Betty who taught Caroline how to play golf, and they taught golf together at Wittinberg for 30 years. It was Betty who convinced Caroline to move to Palm Hill. In 1997, Caroline became a Palm Hiller.

For many years, Caroline and Claire traveled around the country together serving as volunteer marshals at many professional golf events. They attended golf teaching programs where they learned new techniques and tips they brought back to their students.


"Each opportunity we had volunteering in the past has been fun, but teaching the women of Palm Hill is at the top of the list! We loved seeing how excited the women get. Many of our students have never played until they arrive at Palm Hill. We are amazed and happy how quickly they learn and progress," Caroline said.

"Of all of our professional teaching experiences we rarely have had students say – "that was fun! I'll see you next week!" That's why we volunteered here."






