Starting ASAP, as directed by the office, please adhere to the following for trash collection:



- 1. Boxes MUST be broken down & put into the recycle container.
- 2. The roll off container is to have NO bagged garbage in it at all, this includes yard waste. If you have yard waste and it is bagged, please put it into the compactor.
- 3. The roll off container is not bulky furniture or construction material-if it doesn't fit into an outside type garbage can, it does not belong in the dump area and you will need to call someone to haul it off..
- 4. Do not fill the roll off container past the fill line. If it is full, feel free to place your items in front of the container so maint can dump it once the container is emptied.
- 5. Absolutely no paint, chemicals, oil, electronics, etc are permitted in the dump area ever. These items are 100% resident responsibility.



Robo Call

In the event that we need to quickly communicate emergencies or incidents to the entire community (i.e., water shut off; power disruption; etc.), we would like for you to enroll in our free Robo Call Program. Below are the instructions to opt-in to the program:

Have each interested party send a text from their cell phone to (727) 304-4552 with the following message (as indicated) in the body of the text: **Join EBO Res**

Resident will then get a reply asking them to respond with their name and lot number, and once done, the registration is complete.

Parking Rules

The Following rules apply to parking at ALL times

All Residents Must Register their Vehicles

- Do not park on the grass ever
- Do not park on the sidewalk
- No overnight street parking
- Parking update: NEW PARKING STICKER POLICY AND TOWING TO BEGIN JULY 1st. For residents who do not have parking decals for their vehicles (maximum of two vehicles per home), you will need to come into the office to get the appropriate parking decal. Please bring in your vehicle registration. It's important to reiterate that clubhouse parking is for residents and their guests during the hours of 9am-10pm. We are implementing a new process for anyone requesting permission to park their car at the clubhouse overnight. Resident will need to come into the office to register their vehicle, sign an agreement stating that their vehicle will be parked at the clubhouse during the hours

of 10pm to 9am only, and obtain a specialty parking sticker before July 1st or be subject to towing. As previously mentioned, the clubhouse parking area is not designed for all-day overflow parking. Lastly, you can stop into the office to pick up a yellow temporary visitor parking pass for your guest(s). All yellow hang tags must have an expiration date. The old "permanent" guest/visitor passes are invalid and the towing company has been made aware of this.



Reminder on Trash Policies

oing forward, the dump will be open 8-3 on Tues and Friday, and 8-11 on Saturday. We are going to try this to see if we can keep the illegal dumping under control but still giving you all access. A reminder/the rule, if it wont fit in a large size trash can, it does not belong in the dump area. No furniture, chemicals of any kind, propane tanks, paint, electronics, construction debris, grills, etc...ever. The compactor is for your regular bagged up household trash, the big dumpster is for yard waste and the blue container is for recyclables. ANYTHING ELSE IS THE RESIDENTS RESPONSIBILITY TO HAVE HAULED OFF THE PROPERTY because Valet Living won't pick it up either. If you are caught dumping anything else, that is actually a crime, you will be fined by the county, get a violation letter from us, and we will close the area back up. (we don't want that)

Beginning 8/22, the maintenance staff will no longer be going around to pick up trash or yard waste. Valet Living will still pick up your trash, but all of the same policies above apply pertaining to what is allowed in the dump area and what they will and won't pick up. Everything bagged in trash bags and boxes broken down should be it. It doesn't make sense to have them go back and do the same thing we already pay a vendor for and use up man hours when there are so many other things that need attention on the property. This does include yard waste, you will have to take that to the dumpster because Valet Living does not pick that up. I have faith that this will be a smooth transition, if you have any questions, please call us at (727) 531-9105. Thank you.

Boxes MUST be broken down and put into the Recycling container. • No bags whatsoever should be placed in the roll off container. This container is for unbagged yard waste, and other household trash. If you have bagged yard waste, you can put it into the compactor or open the bag and dump the contents into the roll off. • The roll off container is not for bulky furniture or construction material...if it doesn't fit into an outside type of garbage can, it does not belong in the dump area. Just as the park is not responsible for you getting to work on time, paying your cell phone bill, or getting your oil changed, we must follow Pinellas County Solid Waste Ordinances and are not responsible for taking your old mattresses, tires, appliances, TVs, large bulky furniture, paint, batteries, solvents, construction debris, etc. Again, the roll off and compactor is for "household" trash only. Therefore, you will need to arrange to have prohibited items hauled away or you can take it to the landfill which we believe costs approximately

\$11 for a load. The Pinellas County Solid Waste landfill is located at 3095 114th Ave. N., St. Petersburg, FL 33716, about 10 miles away. Their phone number is 727-464-7500. There are several junk removal companies, and we know of one junk hauler, Tampa Bay Junk Pros, who may be offering \$50 off for junk/furniture/ appliance removal. Their number is 727-404-5100. • Do not fill the roll



off container past the fill line, otherwise it will not be emptied resulting in having to lockdown the dumpster area which is inconvenient for all. If it is full, you may place your items to the side of the container so maintenance can put it in for you once the container is emptied.



Parking at the clubhouses and mailboxes continues to be an issue. All day parking in front of the mailboxes and at the clubhouses is prohibited and you may be subject to towing without warning. Clubhouse parking is for residents and guests during the hours of 9AM-10PM. Overflow parking at the clubhouse is between the

hours of 10PM-9AM. Special resident passes are available in the office and this new parking scheme will be effective December 1st. These passes are red in color and do not replace the regular parking stickers...they are supplemental. On December 1st, the towing company will be towing all cars at the clubhouse if they do not display either a red or yellow temporary parking pass. If you need to register one of your vehicles for evening overflow parking at the clubhouse, please stop in the office.

Did you know that there is a difference between "garbage" and "trash"? In a nutshell, "garbage" is typically refuse from the kitchen and bathroom such as food waste, paper products, organic waste, etc. "Trash" is waste such as tires, twigs, old furniture, etc. The approximate rate of decomposition for a paper towel is 4 weeks; an apple core is 2 months; leather and wool are 1-5 years, and a plastic bag is from 10 to 20 years. Understanding how trash and garbage is managed

once it leaves your home may give you a better understanding of why it is important for us to put parameters in place regarding what is placed in the dumpster area. To effectively manage the trash and garbage, please adhere to the following:

- Boxes MUST be broken down and put into the Recycling container.
- No bags whatsoever should be placed in the roll off container. This container is for unbagged yard waste, and other household trash. If you have bagged yard waste, you can put it into the compactor or open the bag and dump the contents into the roll off.
- The roll off container is not for bulky furniture or construction material...if it doesn't fit

into an outside type of garbage can, it does not belong in the dump area. Just as the park is not responsible for you getting to work on time, paying your cell phone bill, or getting your oil changed, we must follow Pinellas County Solid Waste Ordinances and are not responsible for taking your old mattresses, tires, appliances, TVs, large bulky furniture, paint, batteries, solvents, construction debris, etc. Again, the roll off and compactor is for "household" trash only. Therefore, you will need to arrange to have prohibited items hauled away or you can take it to the landfill which we believe costs approximately \$11 for a load. The Pinellas County Solid Waste landfill is located at 3095 114th Ave. N., St. Petersburg, FL 33716, about 10 miles away. Their phone number is 727-464-7500. There are several junk removal companies, and we know of one junk hauler, Tampa Bay Junk Pros, who may be offering \$50 off for junk/furniture/ appliance removal. Their number is 727-404-5100.

• Do not fill the roll off container past the fill line, otherwise it will not be emptied resulting in having to lockdown the dumpster area which is inconvenient for all. If it is full, you may place your items to the side of the container so maintenance can put it in for you once the container is emptied.



These pesticide-free tips will help keep your garden safe from the following animals:

Ants

If ants are coming in from your yard through the cracks of doors and windows, pour a line of cream of tartar where they enter the house, and they won't cross it. Cinnamon sticks, coffee grounds, chili pepper, paprika, cloves, or dried peppermint leaves near the openings will also repel ants. You can squeeze the juice of a lemon at the place of entry and leave the peel there or place cloves of garlic around indoor and outdoor ant pathways. Planting mint around the foundation of your house will also keep ants away.

Aphids (Plant Lice)

Plant chives, marigolds, mint, basil, or cilantro, or place aluminum foil at the base of your plants. The foil reflects light onto the undersides of the leaves, which scares away aphids.

Cockroaches

To keep cockroaches from venturing inside your home, create sachets of catnip and place them around its perimeter. You can also place them inside if cockroaches have already found their way in. (Your cat will love it!) Cockroaches like high places, so put a few sachets on top of shelves and other

elevated surfaces. Bay leaves, cucumbers, and garlic can also help ward off cockroaches.

Fleas and Ticks

Plant mint, sweet woodruff, rosemary, or lavender. You can also try placing cedar chips in your garden. They smell great to you but not to fleas and ticks.

Grasshoppers

Simply spray garlic oil where you don't want them, or plant calendula, horehound (a bitter herb), or cilantro.



Japanese Beetles

Try planting chives, garlic, rue, or catnip.

Mice

Use mint plants, especially peppermint. Mice really dislike peppermint, and they'll avoid any areas where it grows.

Mites

Try planting alder, coriander, or dill, and use rye mulch and wheat mulch.

Rabbits

Sprinkle chili pepper around your plants, and be sure to reapply it if it gets wet. You can even install oven racks around plants—rabbits tend to dislike their texture and the way they feel on their feet. Natural rabbit repellants include bellflowers, astilbes, asters, yarrows, cranesbills, hostas, lavender, sage, and other textured or thorny plants.



Slugs and Snails

Place mint, lemon balm, human hair from a hairbrush, pine needles, cosmos, sage, or parsley in your garden. Keep the edges of your garden clear, and look for places where slugs or snails may want to hide during the day. Focus on creating barriers

around your garden beds, rather than relocation—your yard is inevitably a home for slugs and snails.

It's best to introduce these deterrents by planting them directly whenever possible. However, if some plants aren't available in your area, you can use essential oils. Marigolds—especially French marigolds—are easy to grow, are available in just about any climate, and attract many beneficial insects who will help protect your garden.

By making your yard and garden pesticide-free, you can help support your local ecosystems and sustain native species.
