



an you believe it is December? It doesn't seem possible! So much work took place this fall. The budget was adopted for 2024 keeping additional assessments at bay. Our office administration was further strengthened when we welcomed Mar Kuipers to the team. Real estate transactions have been non-stop while office process and procedures are being improved upon. Our water usage contract was renegotiated bringing down our monthly minimum charge to 3,000 from 4,000 gallons per month. We are looking into the feasibility of individual metering. Our revised rules are with the state for approval and have been distributed. The Roofing Committee is preparing to publish an RFQ for fresh bids. Our two approval committees (Exterior Alterations and Share/Unit Install), along with our office staff, are keeping up with the weekly workflow. The Vision Committee, with Patricia Osmond and Donald Barnes as chair and co-chair, is developing the approach to a park-wide collaboration of brainstorming sessions and planning for park common area improvements. What better time to create our park wish list as we head into the holidays! What will be most important to you? It's time to consider...

With the January 2024 Annual Membership Meeting and Board Member Elections looming on the horizon, we began working in October to offer the option for electronic voting vs. paper ballot options. I'd like to express a special thank you to the volunteers, led by Patricia Osmond, who worked to evaluate and recommend an E-voting software package for implementation. Their efforts are very much appreciated. The group set a positive example of working together to bring change; based on our members' needs.

This year's election seeks to fill three available board member positions presently held by R. Lohrman, M. Stokes & myself. Yes, volunteering in this arena can be a lot of work; but, if you are passionate about living at Sunset Palms and would like to support the community with your expertise, now is the time to get those one-page biographies submitted for consideration. Let's meet the candidates soon!

Our thoughts and prayers are with those who've fallen ill or lost loved ones. May the holidays bring peace and joy to all!

Please note that Board and Committee meetings will still use the SunsetPalms3401@gmail.com account. The office will continue to send out these emails.




