



State Park Annual Passes & Sportsman Fishing Licenses 50% off! (HONEYMOON ISLAND STATE PARK) On Oct. 13, 2023, Governor Ron DeSantis signed Executive Order 23-209 (Great Outdoors Initiative) to encourage outdoor recreational participation by providing economic incentives for Florida residents. With this initiative, the Florida Department of Environmental Protection (DEP) and the Florida Fish and Wildlife Conservation Commission (FWC) are offering steep financial discounts to Florida families for their respective outdoors services.

Starting Oct. 14, 2023, and operating until Jan. 13, 2024, DEP is directed to temporarily offer Florida State Parks annual passes for families and individuals at a 50% discount, while FWC will temporarily be offering its annual resident Gold Sportsman's license, 5-year Gold Sportsman's license, and Lifetime Gold Sportsman's license at 50% reductions.

FWC will also exempt individuals from needing fishing licenses within Florida state parks during this nearly three-month period.

Florida State Parks Annual Passes will have a 50% discount and will be available at the following rates:

Family Annual Pass - \$60, plus tax.

Individual Annual Pass - \$30, plus tax.

The following FWC Gold Sportsman licenses, which include the saltwater fishing, freshwater fishing, and hunting privileges and all associated permits, will also be discounted by 50% and will be available at the following rates, plus applicable fees:

Annual Gold Sportsman - \$50.75.

5-year Gold Sportsman - \$247.75.

Lifetime Sportsman's License

Age 4 or younger - \$201.50.

Ages 5-12 - \$351.50.

Ages 13 and older - \$501.50.

of our country. Lots of information that leads me to want to learn more! Signing off now to get some dinner! Hope you're enjoying warmer days! Karen Jewell



PARK BUSINESS OPEN LETTER TO THE SHAREHOLDERS OF WESTWIND II THANKS TO ELAINE BLANK FOR THIS:

e who have purchased a share in the Westwind II ROC Inc. have a substantial financial investment in the community. It is our responsibility to stay informed, take an interest in the up-keep of the common areas and volunteer to help whenever we can. The ROC board and all officers and committee members are unpaid volunteers. Our board is elected by the shareholders and any shareholder in good standing is eligible to run for the board. My primary purpose in writing this letter is to educate the shareholders of the procedures followed concerning the agenda for ROC meetings. The agenda is typed up by our property manager at the direction of the president of the ROC. The agenda lists items that will come before the board for discussion and sometimes require a vote. If any shareholder wishes the board to put an item on the agenda, it should be written in detail and submitted to the office. The office manager will forward the written request to the board. The board will then either address the concern with the shareholder directly or place the request on the agenda of the next board meeting. Any such request should be submitted to the office at least two weeks prior to the next ROC meeting. Once the agenda is complete, it is posted on the ROC portion of the white board in the clubhouse at least 48 hours prior to the meeting. We as shareholders have a responsibility to be aware of the list of ROC meeting dates as they are published every month in the "Hi-Lites." If you are out of town, you can call the office and request a copy of the agenda be sent to your email address. If you have a question concerning one of the agenda items, you can email any board member whose email addresses are listed on the inside of the cover of the "Hi-Lites." Now that the new audio equipment is installed and running, there will be a protocol for speaking at the meetings. A sheet will be available at the sign in table to put your name and the item number you wish to speak about. When the item is raised and the President asks for comments all who have signed the paper will be recognized. It is the board's intent that the shareholders have every opportunity to have their voice heard. Finally, I would like to restate that we as shareholders have to assume responsibility for staying informed as to what is going on in our community whether you live here year-round or are a snowbird. With the availability of email and zoom, no one has an excuse for not being informed. This is your investment. I hope you will treat it as such.
