

## **Managers Moment**

or those who for some reason haven't received your lot rent increase here are the amounts:

Current rent: 677.00 a month New Lot rent will be 732.00

The late fee is still 50.00 for payments.

If you have a 3rd person or 4th you will need to add the 55.00 increase to what you are paying for your extra people.

Parking at the clubhouse continues to be an issue. Clubhouse parking is for residents and guests during scheduled activities. All day parking at the clubhouse is prohibited. Passes are available at the office for those who need to leave their card overnight.

Did you know there is a difference between "garbage" and "trash"? In a nutshell garbage is typically refused from the kitchen, bathroom such as food waste, paper products, organic waste, etc. "Trash" is such waste as tires, twigs, old furniture, etc. The approximate rate of decomposition on a paper towel is 4 weeks; an apple core is 2 months; leather and wool are 1-5 years, and a plastic bag is from 10-20 years. Understanding how trash and garbage is managed once it leaves your home may give you a better understanding of why it is important for us to put parameters in place regarding what is placed in the dumpsters. To effectively manage the trash and garbage, please adhere to the following:

Boxes MUST be broken down.

No bags whatsoever should be placed in the big roller dumpster. The dumpster is for yard waste only.

The large roller dumpster is not for bulky furniture or construction material...if it doesn't



fit into a regular garbage can, it doesn't belong in the dumpster area. We must follow Pinellas County Waste Ordinances and are not responsible for taking your old mattresses, construction debris, etc. Therefore, you will need to arrange to have prohibited items hauled away or you can take it to the landfill which we believe costs approx. \$11 for a load The landfill is located at 3095 114th Ave. N. St Petersburg about 10 miles away. Their phone number is 727-464-7500. There are also several junk removal companies who may offer you money for your junk, appliances, furniture. One we have heard of is Tampa Bay Junk Pros at 727-404-5100.

#### **Pet Policy**

few things I must point out so there are no questions about your responsibility as a pet owner. Keeping a pet on the property is a privilege and not a right and as such, the following rules must be adhered to, or we will have no choice but to ask you to remove the animal from the property. These rules apply whether the animal is a household pet, an Emotional, Support Animal or Service Animal.

- 1. All animals must be registered with the office, and we will need required documentation for any ESA or Service Animals.
- 2. Dogs are to be always on leashes and the handler must always maintain control of the animal, not letting it run up and jump on people or other animals.
- 3. Pet cats are supposed to be indoor cats only.
- 4. You must pick it up after your pet goes to the bathroom.
- 5. Excessive barking must be controlled so the pet does not bother the neighbors.

The English language is so weird that it's amazing we communicate as well as we do. For instance, English is the only language where you drive on parkways, but you park in driveways. Fundamental schools are very strict and stick to a solid, basic curriculum. Magnet schools specialize in specific areas of study; examples are agriscience, architecture, journalism automotive, business management, culinary arts, nursing (can graduate with LPN degree), engineering and information technology. That's just some of the choices, between fundamental and magnet schools, there are 86 choices! Apply for more than one because they hold lottery drawings for kids to get in. Then you get a book like a college catalog of classes to set your schedule. I think I preferred the days of home economics or shop.
