

#### Tello All,

There will be 2 openings for Board of Director positions coming up in February. Nomination information will be sent to each homeowner in December at the address currently on file with the Association.

A reminder - if you are returning from up north for the season, please ensure you have put a change of address in the box at the clubhouse.

This is the time of year when we have the most visitors. Our by-laws are very specific about how long a visitor can stay - no more than 30 days in a calendar year. If you are planning to lease out your unit, it must be for at least 3 months and a lease application is required to be submitted to the Association for approval at least 10 business days in advance of the start date.

Background checks are required before a lease is approved. It is the homeowner's responsibility as well to make sure visitors or renters are aware of and follow the rules and regulations of the Association. Your cooperation is appreciated.


