



SAFE TRAVELS WITHIN GATEWAY

The early evening darkness presents the need for added precautions when walking, biking and driving along our Gateway neighborhood streets, especially around the clubhouse. Florida does not offer extended twilight. The sunsets and nighttime darkness is upon us in a matter of minutes rather than the hour or so as is common in northern latitudes.

Walkers should wear vests, shirts, or pants with yellow reflective tape to alert drivers of their presence. Please keep in mind you are in a community where drivers are older and are more likely to have visual impairments. Your pet should also have reflective tape attached to their collar or vest.

Bikers, unlighted and wearing dark clothing while riding at night, are all too familiar at Gateway, and it is frankly a miracle that someone hasn't been hit and injured. Bikes should have front and rear lights and reflectors in wheel spokes. Drivers (auto & golf carts) should be especially cautious in the early evening as there are bike riders returning home from work and others heading off to the clubhouse for activities.

Please obey the Gateway 15 mph speed limit, stop at the intersections, and be especially cautious around the clubhouse and at unlit crossing streets where that dark-clothed, unlit biker, golf cart, or walker can suddenly appear from the shadows.



HISTORY OF THANKSGIVING

The United States holiday of Thanksgiving is generally understood to be inspired by the harvest feast celebrated by the citizens of Plymouth Colony (later known as pilgrims) and the Native Americans of the Wampanoag Confederacy in the fall of 1621.

Although there is evidence of earlier thanksgiving celebrations in the Americas by the Spanish in the 16th century and at the Jamestown Colony of Virginia in 1610, following what is known as the "starving times" of 1609, these are not recognized as the "First Thanksgiving", a term coined by the editor Alexander Young in 1841 referring specifically to the account of the 1621 event as given by the Plymouth Colony's chroniclers William Bradford (1590-1657) and Edward Winslow (1595-1655) in *Mourt's Relation* (published 1622), the earliest work on the first year of the establishment of Plymouth Colony.

Sarah Josepha Hale (1788-1879), the writer and editor of the popular periodical *Godey's Lady's Book* (published 1830-1878), campaigned for the national observance of Thanksgiving Day beginning in 1846. She wrote to each sitting president advocating the adoption of the holiday. Still, it was only acted upon in 1863 by President Abraham Lincoln (served 1861-1865) during the American Civil War (1861-1865) to encourage national unity.


