#### **HOA Dues**

By paying your \$10.00 a year HOA dues gives you the popular opportunity to participate in the meetings, ask questions, association nominate, and elect Board members by ballot vote. Only members may vote. One vote per household. New board members are installed at the first meeting in January. Meetings are held on the first Tuesday of the month from October through April. This year because of the Clubhouse construction, the meeting may be held later in December if the Clubhouse isn't open. This means nominations could occur sometime in December. Then voting and installation would occur in January. Only members may nominate and vote.

So, you must have your 2024 membership by January. If you have your 2023 membership you may nominate in December. We are encouraging anyone who plans on attending to get their 2024 membership now.

2024 memberships are now being sold. Sue Sears has the necessary paperwork at her house. By paying your membership dues you will receive a membership card that you can show at the attendance table as you come to the meeting. 


