
















THE HOA OF RANCHERO VILLAGE

WHY OUR VETERANS HAND OUT POPPIES

very year we see our Veterans in front of our favorite supermarkets, and we think we know why they're handing out these little red symbols. But if you're like me and you need a reminder, here's what I've learned from the website: www.arlingtonva.us

"The widespread use of the poppy flower to commemorate veterans began in World War I. The American woman Moina Michael was inspired by the famous poem "In Flanders' Fields," written by the Canadian solider and physician, Major John McCrae, after burying his friend





Lt. Alexis Helmer following the Battle of Ypres in Belgium. In his 1915 poem, McCrae described the poppies that "blow between the crosses, row on row," a reference to the blood-red flowers that sprang up among the soldiers' graves, a common sight along the Western Front. Moina wrote her own poem, "We Shall Keep the Faith," based on McCrae's, and dwelled on the poppy as a symbol of the sacrifice of the soldiers.

The poppy soon became a recognized symbol of the war and its human cost. Allied propaganda posters used the poppy to recruit soldiers and encourage people to buy war bonds. The poppy was also used in ceremonies to remember the war dead."

The poppies are made by disabled veterans, and in the past the donations have gone to the Fisher House, Southwest Guide Dogs, Wounded Warriors, Tunnel to Towers, and the VFW National Home for Children. Thank you for any money you've donated to these causes by accepting these little red poppies.
