

#### **Electronic Payments:**

Please be advised that effective 11/1/23, the management office will no longer accept paper checks or money orders for rent payments. We will require payments via one of the electronic payment methods we have available.

There are several convenient electronic payment options, which are all secure methods to make a rental payment: 1) **Electronic Funds Transfer (EFT)**, 2) **Resident Portal**, 3) **Western Union Bill Payments program** and 4) **CheckFreePay offered by Paylease/Zego**.

If you are not currently signed up for one of our electronic payment methods, you will be required to do so as soon as possible. Should you have any questions or need any assistance in choosing your preferred electronic method of payment, please feel free to call the office at (727) 531-9149.

#### **RoboCall & Text Messaging:**

If you are not presently signed up for this service, I would highly recommend you sign up via the office, so you don't miss out on important management notifications related varying subject matter; park water shut off, Storm related messages, trash and holiday schedules. This is not mandatory, but I believe it would be extremely beneficial for every resident to be enrolled in this program.

#### **Rent Due Date:**

Please note that rent is due on or before the 1st of every month.

Presently the grace period for rent without late charges is the 10th day of the month. October 2023 will be the last month of this grace period.

Effective November 1, 2023, the grace period for rent will be changing to the 5th day of each month before late charges will be assessed to delinquent accounts. Late charges will start being assessed on the 6th day of the month.

DYCA has another good line up of events for December, including the Welcome Home dinner and a New Year's Eve party. Come on out and have a good time!



#### Do we really want to have the Midas touch?



#### Staying fit in old age keeps the brain sharp, study finds

study published in the journal Neurology suggests that keeping physically fit in old age can also keep the brain functioning normally.

"Our study suggests that being physically active in old age could keep



the brain fit," says study author Boukje M. van Gelder.

Physical activity can improve blood flow to the brain and in so doing reduce the risk of dementia, stroke and cognitive decline. Activity could stimulate the growth of nerve cells in the hippocampus, the region of the brain involved in memory function. This could help the

brain prevent further deterioration, because there is a "reserve" of nerve cells available.


The study included data on 295 men between the ages of 70 and 90, born between 1900 and 1920. The study began in 1990, and the men were tracked for physical activity and mental agility over a 10-year period.

Researchers found:

- Men who reduced their physical activity by an hour or more were 2.6 times more likely to suffer cognitive decline than men who maintained their activity levels.
- Men who performed their physical activity at a lower intensity over a 10-year period were 3.6 times more likely to suffer cognitive decline than those who maintained intensity level.

#### Researchers prove learning keeps brain physically fit

Researchers at the Massachusetts Institute of Technology have finally proved that when it comes to brainpower the lowdown is "use it or lose it."





Weil says that even though this learning/brain health connection has been suspected for decades—that this evidence actually shows the physical change in the brain when learning takes place.
