Merry December! Did everyone get their letter from Teakwood? It has very important info, so be sure to read it. If you did not receive the letter let the main office know and we will get one out to you.

Now I don't want to do the finger shaking thing, but I don't see any other choice. This is about water. More specifically, lake water. Lake water is also known as non-potable water for outside use. This water is to be used for lawn watering, home cleaning, automobile cleaning and driveway cleaning. It is against the rules for Teakwood Village residents to use city water for anything outside the home (see page 6 of the Prospectus, item B: Irrigation water). It states: "Irrigation

Pineapple Glazed Ham

1 8-lb smoked half bone- in spiral- cut ham
1 1/2 cups pineapple juice
3/4 cups packed light brown sugar
1/2 cup apple cider vinegar
1 tbs Dijon mustard
1 tbs hot sauce
1/4 tsp ground allspice
1(20-oz) can pineapple slices drained
Maraschino cherries

Preheat oven 325. Wrap ham in aluminum foil, fat side up. Set ham on a rack in a large roasting pan with about 1/4 cup of water. Bake ham until internal temperature reaches 120 about 1 hr 20 minutes.

Make the glaze in a small saucepan. Bring pineapple juice, brown sugar, vinegar, mustard, hot sauce, and allspice to a boil. Reduce heat to medium high and simmer until thick enough to coat a spoon about 15 minutes. Remove from direct heat and set aside on top of the stove to keep warm.

Carefully remove ham from oven. Increase the oven temperature to 425. Brush ham all over with glaze. Arrange the sliced pineapple all over the ham with toothpicks. Add a maraschino cherry to the center of each pineapple. Brush top of ham, pineapple, and cherries with more glaze.

Pecan Pie Bars

2 sticks butter
3/4 cups sugar
1/2 salt
2 1/4 c. flour



For the filling

1 stick of butter
1 c. dark corn syrup
1 c. light brown sugar
4 large eggs
1 tbs. vanilla
1 tsp. salt
3 c. pecan halves

Crust

Preheat oven to 350 degrees

Spray bottom and sides of a 13x9 baking pan
Line with parchment paper or foil letting the excess

extend over the edge of the pan.

Melt butter over medium heat

Cook until butter smells nutty, and the solids turn brown, 6-8 minutes. Immediately pour the butter into a medium bowl. Whisk in the sugar and salt. Add flour and stir until it is fully moistened. Press the crust evenly into the bottom of the baking pan. (The crust will be moist- Press carefully to reach the edges and corners of the pan.)

Bake at 350 for 30 minutes or until the topping is puffed and set (it should not wiggle.) Let cool completely in the pan. Use the excess foil to lift the bars out of pan. Cut into squares to serve.
