

- 1. All renters/visitors required to register and apply for background check at the office. Show proof of age. Owners check-in and also leave departure date. Update your information.
- 2. Permit required for overnight parking in **designated** areas. Overnight street parking is not permitted. Obtain permit at office (5-L) during office hours.
- 3. Speed Limit in park: 10 MPH. Be aware of other cars when parking on streets. They are very narrow. Emergency vehicles should be able to pass easily.
- 4. Check Clubhouse Activity Room # 1 for information on possible sales or rentals available.
- 5. Children must be accompanied by resident adult to use Pool & Clubhouse. <u>All residents are to wear cover-up or Tee shirt when in clubhouse. DO NOT WALK INTO CLUBHOUSE WITH WET FEET!</u>
- 6. SAFETY HINT: Use a FLASHLIGHT when walking during the dark hours after 6:00P. Golf Carts turn lights ON.
- 7. Residents should have Emergency Contact information in their office file, in case of medical problem or weather emergency.
- 8. Any requests for our maintenance staff is to be submitted, IN WRITING, so work order can be generated. No verbal requests, please.

# **Pointe West Community Organizations**

#### 1. Residents Owned Community - ROC

- a. Residents who bought a share in community which owns the land. They display a black permanent tag on their coach.
- b. These residents pay real estate taxes to Pinellas County.
- c. They pay a monthly maintenance fee to the ROC.
- d. Organization elects residents to the Board to govern the running of Pointe West. These (9) directors elect yearly: a president, vice-president, secretary and treasurer.

#### 2. Recreation Association - REC

- a. All residents are eligible to join, paying \$2.50 per person for life.
- b. It's managed by a Board of Directors (9) for rotating three year terms. They then elect a president, vice-president, secretary and treasurer each year.
- c. They plan a Social calendar for winter and summer seasons.

#### 3. Home Owners' Association - HOA

- a. Pointe West Homeowners Association Inc. A not-for profit corporation. The H.O.A. is by law, the official and legally recognized representative.
- b. Members Non-shareholders who rent their lots here regarding, rent increases, park rules and regulations, park amenities, state governing statutes.

#### 4. Federation of Manufactured Homeowners of Florida, Inc.

(FMO) 420 Portsmouth Rd., Largo, Florida (727)530-7539

- a. Members Florida manufactured homeowers.
- b. Objectives represents MFHO regarding state legislation And statutes in Florida.

# Tai Chi Chih







# **Bits and Bobs to Remember**

ffice Reminder: Until further notice the office will be open on Monday through Friday from 9am to 2pm. If you wish to come to the office outside these hours please call to make an appointment (727) 584-8924.



Yellow Directory (Dial Directory): Please contact Donna in the office and let her know of any changes or additions that you would like made. The office number is 727-584-8924, and is located at Lot 5-L.

**Pool Umbrellas:** If you open an umbrella at the pool, PLEASE close it before you leave. We don't want any umbrellas damaged by unexpected storms. If you use it and don't close it, then you may be responsible if it gets broken.

When at the pool, please use proper receptacles for your cigarette butts. They are scattered over the sides of the roads and sidewalks. They not only present a fire hazard when a lit cigarette is flipped onto the ground, but it detracts from the beauty of our Park.

**Bicycles and Golf Carts** - Reminder - please park your bicycles and golf carts in the designated areas only and not on the walkways or in front of the doorways. There is a bicycle rack to the left of the main clubhouse door, and golf carts should park in parking spots. Please keep the sidewalk areas clear and hazard free.

If you are leaving the Park for an extended period please remember to notify the office. Make sure your 'out of the Park' address and phone number are current. 

New Years Superstitions That Could Bring You Good Luck in 2024

et a Midnight Kiss: It may seem like kissing someone at midnight is a way to show your excitement for the new year. But it's thought that if you kiss someone you love as the clock strikes midnight, those sentiments will continue for the next 12 months.

Also, don't loan out any money on New Year's Eve or New Year's Day, and don't start the year with any unpaid debts, or you could set a precedent for the months ahead.

**Fill Up Those Cupboards:** Check and see which grocery stores are open on New Year's Eve, because it's considered bad luck to start the new year with bare cupboards (signaling poverty and hardship).

**Open Those Doors at Midnight:** Actually, just before midnight, so you can let the old year out and welcome the new one. (It doesn't have to be for long—even those who believe in this superstition can get cold!)

**Don't Clean the House:** We can really get behind this superstition. If you're concerned about "sweeping" or "washing" away any luck coming your way, don't do any cleaning—including dishes and laundry.

**Fill Up on Collard Greens and Black-Eyed Peas:** If you want to keep with Southern tradition, eating black-eyed peas and collard greens on New Year's Day will supposedly bring good luck and prosperity, respectively, in the months ahead.

**Avoid the Tears:** Save your tears for another day, because crying on New Year's Day could set a year of sadness in motion.

**Skip Eating Lobster or Chicken:** Many cultures believe that eating lobsters before midnight is bad luck because they move backwards, therefore setting you up for a year of setbacks. Chicken is also a superstitious food to eat on New Year's Eve. Because chickens have wings, all your luck could fly away!

Eat Herring: Whether you like your herring pickled or fresh, eating it in some form at midnight is considered good luck in Germany and Sweden.

Make Some Noise: The tradition of noisemakers and fireworks set off at midnight originated from a superstition that making loud noise at midnight would scare evil spirits and omens away.

Carry an Empty Suitcase Around: It can just be around your house for a few minutes, but in Colombia, it's seen as setting yourself up for adventures in the new year.






