Happy New Year everyone.



nother year is in the rear- view mirror. Why do we feel that as we age time flies by faster. One of my friends' mothers would always laugh at us when we visited her. She would listen to us complaining about how we did not have enough time for work, social engagements, and life's many other commitments. She would always say wait till you get to be my age. Well wow here I am. And she was right time just does have a way of flying by faster now. Believe it or not it appears to be true.

As with everything else there are scientific studies that have asked that very question. As we age, time seems to pass more quickly, and we do not know exactly why. A common explanation for this is that our brains process less information as we grow older, which makes time seem to speed up. While science has not been able to prove this or any other explanation to be true, scientists have put forward a theory that can offer some insights.

Things we can do to make it feel like time is slowing down.

- 1. Be mindful in the present: Paying attention to the moment you're currently living is key to not letting time pass you by. Being fully present, both cognitively and emotionally, could mean anything from observing every nuance in your friend's words to the environmental details around you. Several studies show that folks that practiced mediation felt like time lasted longer than people who do not meditate.
- 2. Seek novelty and new experiences: seeking new experiences can help slow down time. The reason this works is because new experiences cause the brain to write down more memory, and then when you read that back out retrospectively, the event seems to have lasted longer.
- 3. Keep a journal: Keeping a journal can help you slow down time by allowing you to reflect on your experiences and memories. Will also help you appreciate the present moment more.



VETERAN'S CORNER

fforts are underway at the <u>Department of Veterans Affairs</u> to encourage nearly 3 million veterans to come into a VA medical center or clinic and receive a brief five-minute screening for possible exposure to environmental hazards. Under a requirement of the <u>PACT Act</u>, the VA must try to screen all patients enrolled in



VA health care for toxic exposures. To date, it has screened 4.8 million veterans, 40% of whom have reported having at least one concern or experience with potential exposures. Next on the list, however, are the 3 million veterans who are enrolled at the VA but don't receive their medical care in a VA facility.

According to VA Under Secretary for Health Dr. Shereef Elnahal, the department will embark on an "extensive outreach effort" to ensure that those veterans have the chance to be screened. Elnahal said that he is optimistic that the VA will succeed in the effort, given that the veterans already are enrolled in care and the department has at least some contact information for them. He hopes the effort will encourage the veterans to turn to the "VA for their health care more regularly," he added. "I hope that when they come into our brick-and-mortar institutions or otherwise get screened, they realize that we've got a team and set of teams across the country dedicated to veteran care," Elnahal said during a press call with reporters Monday.

The <u>exposure screening process</u> consists of a medical provider asking a patient a set of questions. Those include whether the patient thinks they were exposed to any toxic substances from burn pits, Agent Orange, radiation, contaminated water, or other pollutants; what they think they may have been exposed to; and whether they have questions. The screenings are

to be conducted at least every five years, with the results kept in the veterans' health records, according to the VA. Elnahal said that if a veteran has concerns about exposure or a clinician believes the patient may have a condition related to an exposure, they will be "referred for further care." He could not provide information on whether the screenings have sparked any immediate specialty care referrals and if so, what type of care. But, Elnahal added, VA physicians are trained to understand the veterans' responses and the potential health effects of hazardous materials exposure. According to the department, 97% of its clinicians have completed PACT Act clinical training from the VA's War-Related Illness and Injury Study Center, which is a module for assessing deployment-related environmental exposures.

The <u>PACT Act</u> broadened health care services, disability compensation and benefits for an estimated 5 to 6 million veterans who served overseas during the post-9/11 wars, the first Persian Gulf War and the Vietnam War. The toxic exposure screenings are aimed at those at risk for illness as a result of exposure to burn pits, airborne particulate matter, chemicals such as Agent Orange, toxic water at <u>Camp Lejeune</u> in North Carolina and elsewhere, and other environmental pollutants. Elnahal said that the VA will make every effort to screen all its patients but, ultimately, it's the veterans' decision.

A Nurse's Self Care Toolbox #66

This issue is the second part of 3 on choosing or changing your Medicare Part C (Medicare Advantage Plans) Before you join for the first time from regular Medicare or want to change from your current Medicare Advantage plan, take the time to find and compare Medicare Advantage health plans in your area.

Remember that the guidance last month and this issue are <u>not for</u> Medi-gap plans. Vastly different healthcare coverage as those plans helps defray costs to us between what regular Medicare has paid and what we will finally pay (helps pay the gap.)

Once you understand the plan's rules and costs, it is important to call the actual health plan on their toll-free number and NOT a health insurance broker as they help enroll in multiple plans thus may try to steer you to something different then why you called. *Medicare agents usually receive a commission for each enrollee*. Here is how to join:

- Use **Medicare's Plan Finder.** Online version. Do not have a computer use a smartphone or tablet plus perhaps a neighbor has one.
- Visit the plan's website to see if you can join online.
- Fill out a paper enrollment form. Contact the plan to get an enrollment form, fill it out, and return it to the plan. All plans must offer this option.
- Call the plan you want to join. Get your plan's contact information.
- Call 1-800-MEDICARE (1-800-633-4227). TTY: 1-877-486-2048.

When you join a Medicare Advantage Plan, you'll have to give these:

- Your Medicare numbers if more than you,
- The date your Part A and/or Part B coverage started.

This information is on your Medicare card. *** If you cannot find it call Medicare and get one. Same if you cannot find your Social Security card.

Medicare plans are not allowed to call you to enroll you in a plan unless you specifically ask to be called. Also, plans should **never ask you** for financial information, including credit card or bank account numbers, over the phone.

No one should call you without your permission or come to your home uninvited to sell Medicare products. Call 1-800-MEDICARE to report a plan that does this.

➤ However, many Medicare Advantage plans have a representative close by who can come to our home and assist. Especially helpful if we might be eligible for extra benefits due to our long-term health issues!

Below are the most common types of Medicare Advantage Plans.

- Health Maintenance Organization (HMO) Plans. You have a Primary Care Physician, will need a referral for specialty care. Providers, including hospitals, must be in the health plans network! If only a Florida health plan, then ask about traveling out of Florida. Examples: going back home for the holidays and travel.
- Preferred Provider Organization (PPO) Plans. Maximum primary and specialty reimbursements must be in the plans network of providers.
- Private Fee-for-Service (PFFS) Plans. A menu of options.
- Special Needs Plans (SNPs). Also being eligible for Medicaid is an example. Next month is the last issue on this topic and on the disadvantages of Part C, Medicare Advantage plans. Till next month.
