

They were originally scheduled to play for us on Saturday, January 27th however, due to the planned cruise on that date and the number of residents going, it has been decided to advance the date of the dance party to Wednesday, January 24th from 7:00PM to 10:00PM. This dance will be free for all, just bring your own beverage of choice and snacks, ice will be provided. A 50/50 raffle will be held. This duo is not to be missed!!

December 7 Board of Directors Meeting

quorum was met. Meeting highlights: Financial - The cash position is solid and on track with budget. YTD \$23,000 excess, revenue over expenses. Month of November income was \$32,000. Utility costs were high. Insurance will be under budget. Approved the return of \$5,000 taken out of the operating account in January back into the reserve account. CIT CD which came due plus additional funds from the reserve account were rolled over for 6 months at 5%. Grounds/Maintenance – No stormwater galvanized pipes were found at the entrance area, all were PVC. About 25 seized values will need to be replaced by isolating values, those to be prioritized; about \$300-\$400 each. 8 in December, others in 2024. Could be an \$3500 expenditure. Gurrin thanked Peter Palmieri, Unit 36, for his help, as well as the many residents who pitched in to help, saving the park lots of money. Three new palm trees were planted and stumps ground down, cost was \$1707. More will need to be replaced. Palm trees were trimmed, \$4000. Purchased eight new batteries for the utility cards at a cost \$1400; some used ones were moved to the 2nd cart. Will need 8 more new batteries, \$2800 in total for all new cart batteries; will be over budget. New pool cover (\$600) was ordered at no cost except shipping because old one was covered under warranty. Tie-down program is available to all residents at no cost and will commence in January. Extended stay for guests over 30 days require a \$100 background check and board approval; CV's additional charge \$50 a month.

Mobile Home Tie-Down Program

There was an overwhelming response to the December 4th Tie-Down presentation when representatives explained the State of Florida Hurricane Loss Mitigation Program which is paid in full from funds furnished AT NO EXPENSE TO THE RESIDENTS. The State of Florida and Gulf Coast State College (SCSC) Mobile Home Tie-Down Program involves only the enhancement of the tie-down and anchoring system of the unit. The program does not intend to bring existing mobile homes up to code but to make the home as wind resistant as funding, physical characteristics and condition of premises permit. Will this program encourage more insurance companies to offer mobile home insurance in Florida? Will the insurance premiums for those participating stabilize? It is anticipated that a large number of mobile home parks will make application and the funds available will be exhausted. CV was granted funds for all residents who apply. Residents can pick up this application from the Park Office. Work is expected to begin in January 2024. Residents do not need to be home at the time.

Watering Restrictions Schedule and Rules

he Southwest Florida Water Management District has issued a modified Stage 1 Water Shortage for Pinellas County. Beginning, Dec. 1, 2023, Pinellas County Utilities will move to one-day-per-week watering for all water customers. Please see the new watering restrictions/schedule below.



We urge everyone to reduce wasteful and unnecessary water use and be prepared for more stringent restrictions if drought conditions worsen.

Visit pinellas.gov/watering-schedule-and-rules for the current water schedule. Please monitor this page for up-to-date water schedule information as restrictions can change at any time. Residents who do not receive their water from PCU should verify their watering days and restrictions with their water supplier. The authorized irrigation schedule using reclaimed, potable, well, lake or pond sources for all **Pinellas County Utilities customers is as follows:**

Customers south of SR580 - Largo Area

- Addresses ending in even numbers (0, 2, 4, 6, 8): Tuesdays
- Addresses ending in odd numbers (1, 3, 5, 7, 9): Thursdays
- Mixed or No Address (such as common areas, entry areas/office complexes, shopping centers and other "no address" locations): Thursdays

Watering is not permitted between 10 a.m. and 4 p.m.

Irrigation is prohibited between 10 a.m. and 4 p.m. During daylight saving time (second Sunday in March until the first Sunday in November) irrigation is limited to no more than two days per week on scheduled days.






