CONCERN OF RULE VIOLATIONS, PLEASE BE AWARE

VIII. Conduct, Complaints, Compliance, and Default:

- 1. Any and all acts which endanger the life, health, safety, property of the park or its occupants will not be permitted and are in violations of the rules of Golden Gate Shareholders.
- 2. Any complaints regarding any of the rules in the governing documents by a Shareholder or their guests are to be written of a complaint form (available in the office) and must name the resident or guest against whom the complaint is being filed, specify the rule being violated and when alleged violation occurred, be signed and dated and presented to the office.

Prospective Homebuyers

- 1. Application to purchase a home in Golden Gate to be completed in the Golden Gate Office.
- 2. Payment for the background check to be required at this time.
- 3. Prior to closing, applicant(s) to be interviewed by the board of directors in order to become a resident of Golden Gate.
- 4. Upon closing and receiving the occupancy agreement from the clerk of courts, a share will be issued to complete residency requirements.





(7) \overline{A} golf cart may not be operated on public roads or streets by a person:


(a) Who is under 18 years of age unless he or she possesses a valid learner's driver license or valid driver license.
