

al Morris is a violinist and musician who splits his time between both coasts, and his childhood home is Oklahoma. 



- 1. Eat like a champion: Eat more whole, unprocessed foods like fruits, vegetables, lean proteins, and whole grains. Include naturally fermented foods like live sauerkraut and plain yogurt. Avoid sugar. Use smaller plates. Drink more water. Drink herbal tea instead of snacking. Only eat until you are 80% full.
- 2. Move your beautiful body: Get at least 150 minutes of moderate aerobic exercise per week. Find activities you enjoy, like walking, cycling, or dancing. - 6. Focus on the journey: Learn to find joy in the journey! Focus on overall health, and as you feel better overall, you will be more likely to continue your weight loss journey. Keep your goal in mind, but keep your focus on every small achievement and celebrate your progress.
- 7. Establish a support system: Find a group or a friend in your community with common goals for accountability and motivation. 

The friendly match of the year between Canadian and USA golfers is only a few weeks away. On Friday January 26th, we will play golf to determine who will raise the Tin Cup.


