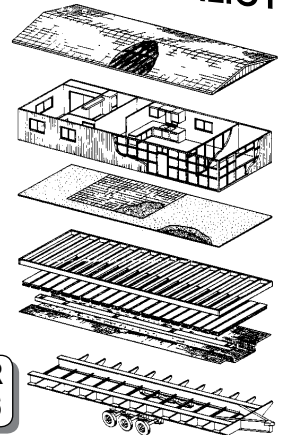

Cal Morris is a violinist and musician who splits his time between both coasts, and his childhood home is Oklahoma. The very next year, Cal was diagnosed with a rare blood cancer (MDS-Myelodysplastic Syndrome). After a very long four-year battle with cancer and chemo, bone marrow transplants from his brother Micah, and near death in ICU, his life was saved and he returned to music.

Cal taught himself how to play the piano with his twin brother at the age of six and immediately fell in love with the magic of music. At age thirteen they decide to pursue violin and a few months later Dr. Hong Zhu from the University of Central Oklahoma heard him play. He wanted to take them on as classical students, and they wanted to learn as much as they could.

Cal is a classically trained violinist with a deep love of symphony orchestra and cinematic soundtracks, mixed with a modern millennial and current music. “The Instrument Is the Singer” and you will most certainly not be disappointed. 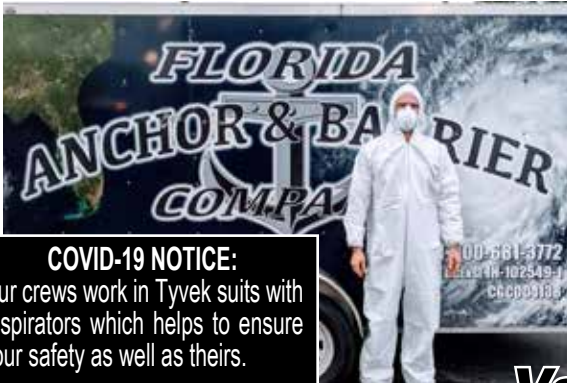

7 Proven Strategies for Weight Loss - January urges us to take stock of our health, and weight loss often tops the list of resolutions. 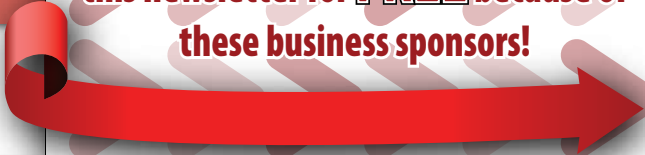

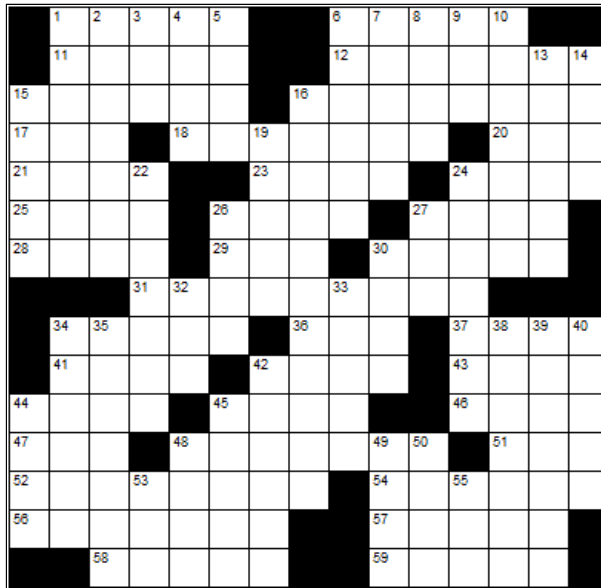

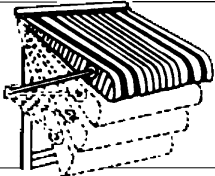

7. All exterior modifications, regardless of type and nature, require an application to be submitted to the Architectural Review Committee (ARC). The ARC Modification Form is available on the FVRA website or you can contact the Office and request the form.

9. The City of Largo is the Associations trash management company. Trash pickup is Mondays & Thursdays. Recycling pickup is on Thursdays.
