Have questions and need to contact us? You can knock on the office door, you can call, or you can fill out a request/concern form and drop it in the box located at the front door of the office.



Option 1: Go to Facebook, and search for Doral Village. Look for the Doral Village entry that has a photo of the front area,then you need to request to join.the group. If you are a Resident of Doral the request will be approved.

Option 2: Go to the Doral web page and click on the Login button. After logging in you will see a Link to 801 News.

There seems to be a renewal of issues with vehicle parking (Autos & Golf Carts). DO NOT park on the grass around the park and remember that in addition to no parking on the streets overnight, the parking at the Cottage and Clubhouse is limited to those vehicles with VISITOR tags during overnight hours.
