Veteran's Corner

In an era of political unrest, more than 265,000 women volunteered to go to Vietnam where they were needed. They were Combat nurses. These young women averaged 23 years of age, and risked their lives to care for our country's wounded and dying. Often being flown in by helicopter under enemy fire, to triage and evacuate our wounded



soldiers. They received no fanfare or public notice. These quiet heroes faced the casualties of war with steel nerves.

An evolution in trauma and combat casualty care was witnessed during my tour in Vietnam. Like other American soldiers, Army nurses served a 12 month tour.

The nurses worked six days per week, 12 hours per day. During emergencies, everyone worked. Rest and relaxation were rare treats.

Despite the physical and emotional demands that could overwhelm nurses, there were many rewards. These included the gratitude of the soldiers they cared for, and the feelings of being needed and appreciated.

The nurses were the greatest contribution to morale because the soldiers knew they were going to be cared for if they were injured.

In Vietnam there were no front lines or safe areas. Enemy forces could strike anywhere, but some areas were more susceptible to attack than others.

The Army Nurses/Combat Nurses cared for soldiers in their greatest hour of need. They comforted, and made sure no patient died alone.

The nurses endured countless hours of their patients pain and suffering.

And when there time there was over, they quietly came home. All nurses paid an emotional price for that year in Vietnam.

May they be remembered always.




