Manager's Moment

Te hope that you all had a wonderful holiday and we wish everyone. a happy and healthy New Year! Let us start his new year off right! MANAGER I know it may seem like some of the rules are annoying, frustrating, and even confusing, but we try our best to adhere to the Rules and Regulations put in place to keep our communities safe, clean, and attractive. There are always going to be concerns and different personalities, especially living in a community like ours where we are so close to each other. I just want to review a few concerns that came across my desk last year and hopefully we can avoid having them continue or occur less in 2024.

The first is BARKING DOGS. Yes, we all understand dogs bark; we also understand it is your responsibility to control them so they do not disturb residents. If they do, would it hurt to take the time to apologize to your neighbor for the disturbance? There are many (2 1/2 pages) of rules about pets, please take the time to refresh your memory.

If you have an issue with someone else's pet, we ask that you report it in writing to the office so that it can be addressed.

Secondly: NO DRINKING ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES allowed at the pool--again not only one of our rules but the law of Pinellas County Section 64E.

There are designated areas for smoking, please use them. Our pool cleaning company has reported cigarette butts, wrappers, and trash in the filter. This causes more problems for pool maintenance and it is the result of negligent behavior by the people using the shared facilities.

We have many residents here that invite their children/grandchildren to spend a day with them at the pool so let us respect one another's time while enjoying this activity and don't let young children jump in the pool or splash around obnoxiously when other residents are also trying to enjoy themselves quietly.

Here in the office, we cannot stress enough that if you are selling your home you need to first have your home inspected by Management for any violations, the violations then fixed, and an Owners Authorization form must be filled out and handed into the office BEFORE ANY TRANSACTION can be made. A new application for a resident will not be processed until all of this has happened. If you are using a Mobile Home Re-Seller, they need to be informed of this policy as well. Call the office and one can be emailed to you or I can hand one to you if you stop in. The purpose of this policy is to ensure that no one is buying a home that is in violation from the get-go and to maintain the integrity of the property.



INFORMATION ABOUT WATER:

Tasteful and Unnecessary Use of Water Is Prohibited!

These are the basic rules from the Pinellas County website:

Examples of wasteful water usage:



Allowing water to flow from an unattended hose.

Hand-watering a lawn on a restricted day or more than once a day.

Hosing down a driveway or solid surface or structure when a dry method could be used.

Allowing water to flow from a broken sprinkler head or outdoor faucet and having malfunctioning plumbing/-irrigation system after receiving verbal or written notice.

Violations

The Year-Round Conservation Measures and Seasonal Reclaimed Water Restrictions allow the first violation of these restrictions to be issued as a "warning" Notice of Violation. In accordance with Sixth Judicial Circuit Administrative Order No. 2018-068 PI-CTY, Local Ordinance Violations, and Fish and Wildlife Conservation Commission Violations Uniform Fine Schedule, Attachment A, Miscellaneous Ordinance, Marine Patrol, Fish, and Wildlife Conservation Commission, and Natural Resources Violation fines start at \$193, and may be doubled for a second offense; and for each subsequent offense thereafter. Contested citations may result in the cost of a fine plus additional court costs. For more information after receiving a citation, please contact Business & Customer Services at (727)464-4000.

Protect Your Hot Water Heater During a Water Outage

During an extended water outage, you may want to turn off the water heater by going to the electrical panel and throwing the water heater breaker to the "Off" position. Once the water has been restored, residents should turn the hot water on at a few faucets and make sure that all of the air is out of the lines. Once there is no sputtering and the water is running smoothly, the breaker can be switched back on. This process is to keep the water heater elements from overheating and burning out if the water level gets too low.

Ducks/Wildlife

Please do not feed or put out feeders accessible to ducks or other wildlife. It is illegal in the state of Florida and you could be charged a \$100 fine for each infraction, and it is a violation of the park. Not only that, but if you put out food for the ducks, anything will eat it--stray cats, rats, snakes, and opossums--to name a few. So please don't do it. Thank you!

Smoking and Drinking at the Pool

There is a designated smoking area at the pool and if you smoke, you will be required to smoke there and only there. Also, cigar smoking is offensive to most people and is strictly prohibited at the pool. Violators will lose their privileges to the pool, and if that doesn't work, we will make the pool completely non-smoking. Every week, the pool company finds butts in the filters. clogging them up and leading to downtime on the pumps which means the pool is closed until repairs are made.


Also, per the health department and code enforcement, drinking alcohol at a public pool is strictly prohibited. NO GLASS OR CANS OF ALCOHOL ARE PERMITTED. The health department will shut down the pool and if we find bottles in the trash we will be forced to shut down the pool as well.

The bottom line is that this is a community which means that the amenities are for everyone. Please be considerate of your neighbors and follow these simple rules so that everyone can enjoy a day by the pool. Thank you.

Pet Policy



few things about pets I want to point out so there are no questions about your responsibility as a pet owner. Keeping a pet on the property is a privilege and not a right and as such, the following rules must be adhered to or we will have no choice but to ask you to remove the animal from the property. These rules apply whether the animal is a household pet, an Emotional Support Animal, or a Service Animal.

- 1. ALL animals must be registered with the office, and we will need all required documentation for any ESA's or Service Animals.
- 2. Dogs are to be on leashes AT ALL TIMES and the handler must maintain control of their animal at all times, not letting it run up or jump on people or other animals.
- 3. Pet cats are supposed to be indoor animals only.
- 4. You MUST pick up after your pet goes to the bathroom—we do have doggy pots at both properties that have the bags and a container just for that.
- 5. Excessive barking must be controlled so the pet is not bothering the neighbors. I seem to hear this a lot and it is against park rules.

Speeding

SPEED LIMIT 10

here are WAY too many people driving WAY TOO fast in our park. I consider this a SERIOUS NO-NO because we have a LOT of residents riding their bikes or strolling through the neighborhood and many of them

use walkers or scooters/wheelchairs and can't move quick enough to avoid an accident. We also have a LOT of beautiful wildlife roaming the park—ducks, turtles, all kinds of birds and the cute little cotton-tail rabbits we see everywhere—and we need to PROTECT them AND our ambulatory residents.. The speed limit is 10 MPH. I think most of our neighbors adhere to this and it is the visitors who are breaking the rules. If you see someone driving too fast, get their license plate number so we can report them to the office. If it is, indeed, a visitor, they can lose the privilege of coming into the park. I think this is VERY important and so should you. Let us all work together to get this problem fixed!

PS-If you think it may be any of your family members or friends (sorry, but it happens), PLEASE tell them to respect YOU by respecting the rules of the place you call home. Also, please let your company know to turn down their RADIOS when within the parameters of the park. Again, they should respect YOU enough to do this. Thank you!




