Printed copy of the Voice delivered to your door every month by volunteers from the Lincolnshire. Our Voice newsletter is provided free to our community by Monthly Media publications. This is possible, thanks to the vendors that pay to advertise their services throughout the newsletter. They print newsletters for over sixty plus Communities in Florida.

Did you know that you can look at our newsletter online? Great for our part time residents that want to stay up on Lincolnshire happenings while they are away over the summer months.

Did you also know that the Monthly Media has monthly drawings for monetary prizes from \$5.00, \$10.00 and \$100.00. If you utilize any of the vendors advertised in the Voice. Make sure you ask the vendor for an entry form. Complete the small form and place it in the white box mounted on the wall in the laundry room. The box is labeled Monthly Media. When they deliver our Voice copies to Quinn Elock every month, they take the slips from the box and enter them into the drawing. Take a minute to check the section called Monthly Mania on the last page of the monthly newsletter to see if your name is listed as a winner. They will send you a check in the mail.

If you want to look at our newsletter on-line, simply enter www.monthly-media.com in your search bar. On the home page click on Park newsletters. Lincolnshire is in the Eagle Zone section. You can just click on the photo of the newsletter to read it or download it and our monthly calendar to your computer/phone.







RECEIPE FOR FEBRUARY

Chicken Noodle Soup – Great for a rainy-day supper, or comfort food if you are not feeling well. Better yet make a batch to share with a neighbor that is "under the weather".

Yield 4 servings.

Ingredients: 1/2 medium onion, thinly sliced

- 1 small carrot, thinly sliced.
- 2 stalks celery, thinly sliced.
- 2 sprigs fresh thyme
- 2 sprigs flat-leaf parsley
- 6 cups chicken broth, homemade or low-sodium purchased

½ cup water

Kosher salt and freshly ground black pepper.

1/3 pound egg noodles (preferably not wide)

1-1/4 cups shredded cooked chicken (meat from about 1 breast)

1 tablespoon whole flat-leaf parsley leaves for garnish

Directions:

- 1. Put the onion, carrots, celery, thyme, parsley, chicken broth and water in a medium pot. Season with salt and pepper to taste. Bring to a simmer over medium high heat. Simmer until the vegetables are almost tender, about 5 minutes.
- 2. Add the noodles and cook until tender, 5 to 8 minutes (depending upon the size of the noodles). Add the chicken, warm through, and then adjust the seasoning, if necessary, with salt & pepper. Serve with parsley garnish.

These include "Sanford and Son," "The Jeffersons" and, of course, "All in the Family." He joined the Army Air Forces after the attack on Pearl Harbor and flew 52 bombing missions over Nazi-occupied territory as a radioman in a B-17 Flying Fortress.

Henry Kissinger = As a young Jewish man, Henry Kissinger was forced to flee his native Germany with his parents, finding safety from Nazi persecution in the United States. Six years later, he would write to his parents from Germany, having returned as an American soldier to end the Nazi regime. He gained his citizenship while in basic training in 1942. In 1944, he sailed for Europe in time for the Battle of the Bulge and to liberate the Hannover-Ahlem concentration camp. In the years that followed, he rose from Army private to NCO in the Counter Intelligence Corps (Army CIC), chasing down former members of the Gestapo.

Bob Knight - At age 24, Knight was the head coach of the Army Black Knights basketball team. But just two years before that, he was an active duty enlisted soldier stationed at the U.S. Military Academy and working for the basketball team.

Tony Bennett - Anthony Dominick Benedetto went into World War II Europe as an infantry rifleman, but he left as a singing member of the Special Services, inspired by Bob Hope's USO shows and ready to make a lifelong passion into a career. He called the combat part of war a "front row seat in hell," and who could blame him? He fought his way into Germany and liberated part of the Dachau concentration camp complex Tony Bennett before coming home to New York City.

Harry Belafonte - As World War II raged on around the world, the future "King of Calypso" and civil rights icon joined the U.S. Navy from his hometown of New York City at age 17. He served for 18 months, from 1944 until the war's end. As a Black sailor, he was not assigned to a frontline job in the Pacific. Instead, he loaded ships bound for that theater.

Bud Grant - Grant is remembered as No. 3 on the list of all-time most successful football coaches, with 283 wins across both the National Football League and the Canadian Football League. He graduated high school in 1945, eager to get into World War II, and joined the Navy to be a crewman aboard a landing ship. The war ended before he could finish training, but he played football at Great Lakes Naval Training Center

Burt Bacharach - Grammy-, Oscar- and Tony-winning musician Burt Bacharach was drafted by the Army in the late 1940s and was still on active duty when the Korean War broke out. He never saw action in Korea, however. He played piano at officer's clubs in Germany and the United States, mostly improvised tunes or pop songs of the day until 1952.

- ❖ What are the <u>disadvantages</u> to a Medicare Advantage plan?
- Medicare Advantage can become expensive if you are sick, due to uncovered copays especially if hospitalized. No guarantee that all the providers and vendors like your DME (oxygen and concentrators as examples) are included in the plan when that happens. Leading to changes.

Always ask! All benefits are available in both print (Medicare mandate) and online through the plan's website. *Remember to select the plan you want or selected. At least the sections on ER, outpatient tests like CT's/MRI's and hospitalizations.

- Additionally, a plan may offer only a limited network of doctors, which can interfere with a patient's choice. **Make sure your favorite Primary Physician is still eligible to be your Primary! Specialists too if you see them often. Also call them to ensure they are still participating.
- And it is not easy to change to another plan. If you decide to switch back to a Medigap policy, there often are lifetime penalties. Windows in time where changes are possible are limited each year. Why necessary homework pays off.
 - ❖ Types of Medicare Advantage Plans. *Know what you are getting!*
- ✓ Health Maintenance Organization (HMO) members usually receive services through the plan's local network of providers. Referrals to see a specialist and other providers are required. However, plans allow out-of-network care for emergencies and out-of-area dialysis. Prescription drug coverage is included in HMO plans, and many plans include some coverage for dental, vison, and hearing. Again, our favorite Dentist may not participate in that plan.
- ✓ Preferred Provider Organization (PPO) members can usually use in-network Doctors, hospitals, pharmacies, and other healthcare providers that agree to health plan members' services and supplies at a set price are in-network providers. However, visits to non-network providers could cost significantly more. PPO plans often include prescription drug coverage and other benefits, and referrals are typically not required for specialist visits.
- ✓ Medicare Medical Savings Account (MSA) plans are private companies that the Medicare program pays to manage a beneficiary's Medicare benefits. As with all types of Medicare Advantage plans, MSA plans must offer the same basic benefits included in Medicare Part A Medicare Part A is hospital coverage for Medicare beneficiaries. These plans are usually not well selected due to the rules of coverage.
- ✓SNP. Special Needs Plans. Often associated with Medicaid or can be a subset of Medicare Advantage plans for those with chronic health conditions like CHF, Asthma, kidney failure, Diabetes plus others. If medical history, medical history, and Physician attestation meet qualifications there can be a reduction in Medicare Part B costs, assistance for medication costs and other helpful options.

Please note that Medicare Advantage Plans use their additional funding from Medicare to provide over-the-counter purchases, rides to medical appointments, exercise programs, monthly food cards to help defray the costs of eating healthy foods and other. NOT all plans offer the same extras!




