



Mardi Gras

ardi Gras refers to events of the Carnival celebration, beginning on or after the Christian feasts of the Epiphany (Three Kings Day) and



Costumes

Mardi Gras, as a celebration of life before the more-somber occasion of Ash Wednes-day, nearly always involves the use of masks and costumes by its participants, and the most popular celebratory colors are purple, green, and gold. In New Orleans, for ex-ample, these often take the shape of fairies, animals, people from myths, or various Medieval costumes[26] as well as clowns and Indians (Native Americans).[27]

Many costumes today are simply elaborate creations of colored feathers and capes. Unlike Halloween costumery, Mardi Gras costumes are not usually associated with such things as zombies, mummies, bats, blood, and the like, though death may be a theme in some. The Venice tradition has brought golden masks into the usual round of costumes.

King Cake

By far the most delicious of New Orleans' Mardi Gras traditions is the King Cake. Between Twelfth Night and Fat Tuesday, you can find king cakes lining the walls of local grocery stores.

Traditionally, a New Orleans king cake is an oval-shaped coffee cake, braided and covered in icing and sugar the color of Mardi Gras: purple, green and gold. A small plastic baby accompanies each king cake (Due to choking hazards, most king cakes now come with the baby on the outside, allowing the buyer to place it inside of the cake). King cake custom demands that whoever cuts the slice of cake that has the ba-by in it is king for the day — and also has to purchase the next king cake.

Mardi Gras Colors

The traditional (and official) colors of Carnival are purple, green and gold. The colors were selected by Rex in 1872 to honor the visiting Russian Grand Duke Alexis Ale-xandrovich Romanoff, whose house colors were purple, green and gold. These royal colors are each symbolic: purple stands for justice, gold for power and green for faith.





Ground Hog Day

id You Know ?

Groundhog Day, in the United States and Canada, day *February 2nd* (February 2) on which the emergence of the groundhog (woodchuck) from its burrow is said to foretell the weather for the following six weeks. The beginning of February, which falls roughly halfway between the winter solstice and the spring equinox, has long been a significant time of the year in many cultures. Among the Celts, for example, it was the time of Imbolc, observed in anticipation of the birth of farm animals and the planting of crops, and February 2 is also the date of the Christian festival of Candlemas, also called the feast of the Purification of the Blessed Virgin. During the Middle Ages there arose the belief that animals such as the badger and the bear interrupted their hibernation to appear on this day. If the day was sunny and the animal saw its shadow, six more weeks of winter weather remained. If, however, the day was cloudy, it was a sign that the weather during the following weeks would be mild, leading to an early spring. German immigrants to the United States carried the legend with them, and in Pennsylvania the groundhog came to be substituted for the badger.

Since 1887 an animal in Punxsutawney, in the west-central part of the state, has been the center of a staged appearance each February 2. In what has become a media event, a groundhog designated Punxsutawney Phil is the center of attention of television weathermen and newspaper photographers. Although promoters of the local festival surrounding Punxsutawney Phil claim that the animals have never been wrong, an examination of the records indicates a correlation of less than 40 percent. (Whether a groundhog does or does not emerge is thought to be related to the amount of fat it was able to store before going into hibernation.) Canada has a number of groundhogs that serve as weather prognosticators, perhaps the best known being those portraying Wiarton Willie, a white-furred, pink-eyed creature that has appeared on the Bruce Peninsula, northwest of Toronto, since 1956.

ses for Dawn Dish Soap that have Nothing to do with Washing Dishes **1. Degrease those tools:**

Run about a gallon of hot water and put a TBSP of this blue gold and that grime will wipe away. Tip: Use old rags to clean them and another to dry them off right away. We don't want any rust!

2. Garden pest fighter.

You've worked so hard to have such a beautiful garden and then the dreaded aphids show up. If you haven't heard of aphids, you haven't been gardening for very long.

An aphid is a tiny bug that sucks the sap right out of plants. Even worse, they make babies so fast that before you know it, you have an infestation. They will ruin your garden.

Don't worry. The bees and ladybugs will be just fine. Won't hurt them at all.

Mix 2.5 TBSP of Dawn with a gallon of water and spray the tops and bottoms of the leaves. You'll have to do it for a few days to get rid of the little buggers.

(Please be sure to test a little on your plant before spraying it completely.)

3. Clean hairbrushes with Dawn dish soap.

Make sure you get all the hair out of your hairbrushes – or at least as much as you can.

You'll need a TBSP of Dawn and a TBSP of 20 Mule Team Borax and hot water. Mix it all up (I put it in my sink) and soak your hairbrushes until they're clean..5. Prevent paint from sticking to your skin.

Think about how many times, in just one day, fingers touch cabinets. Holy cow! They'll definitely start to look gross if we don't clean them – especially around the spots where we open and close them.

Using the exact same method you used cleaning stainless steel, clean your cabinets. But first, please check a small spot somewhere inconspicuous to be sure it doesn't cause any damage.

7. Clean car tires and hubcaps with Dawn dish soap.

Hose them off really well and then put some Dawn on a rag and start scrubbing away. It's amazing how well it will clean them up.

Don't forget to rinse them off after you're done to get all the soap off.
