

1. All renters/visitors required to register and apply for background check at the office. Show proof of age. Owners check-in and also leave departure date. Update your information.

2. Permit required for overnight parking in **designated** areas. Overnight street parking is not permitted.

Obtain permit at office (5-L) during office hours.

3. Speed Limit in park: 10 MPH. Be aware of other cars when parking on streets. They are very narrow. Emergency vehicles should be able to pass easily.

4. Check Clubhouse Activity Room # 1 for information on possible sales or rentals available.

- 5. Children must be accompanied by resident adult to use Pool & Clubhouse. All residents are to wear cover-up or Tee shirt when in clubhouse. DO NOT WALK INTO CLUBHOUSE WITH WET FEET!
- 6. SAFETY HINT: Use a FLASHLIGHT when walking during the dark hours after 6:00P. Golf Carts turn lights ON.

7. Residents should have Emergency Contact information in their office file, in case of medical problem or

weather emergency.

8. Any requests for our maintenance staff is to be submitted, IN WRITING, so work order can be generated. No verbal requests, please.

Pointe West Community Organizations

1. Residents Owned Community - ROC

- a. Residents who bought a share in community which owns the land. They display a black permanent tag on their coach.
- b. These residents pay real estate taxes to Pinellas County.

c. They pay a monthly maintenance fee to the ROC.

d. Organization elects residents to the Board to govern the running of Pointe West. These (9) directors elect yearly: a president, vice-president, secretary and treasurer.

2. Recreation Association - REC

- a. All residents are eligible to join, paying \$2.50 per person for life.
- b. It's managed by a Board of Directors (9) for rotating three year terms. They then elect a president, vice-president, secretary and treasurer each year.
- c. They plan a Social calendar for winter and summer seasons.

3. Home Owners' Association - HOA

- a. Pointe West Homeowners Association Inc. A not-for profit corporation. The H.O.A. is by law, the official and legally recognized representative.
- b. Members Non-shareholders who rent their lots here regarding, rent increases, park rules and regulations, park amenities, state governing statutes.

4. Federation of Manufactured Homeowners of Florida, Inc.

a. Members – Florida manufactured homeowers.

b. Objectives – represents MFHO regarding state legislation And statutes in Florida.



(New) Bits and Bobs to Remember

ffice Reminder: Until further notice the office will be open on Monday through Friday from 9am to 2pm. If you wish to come to the office outside these hours please call to make an appointment (727) 584-8924.

Water Restrictions Reminder: The Southwest Florida Water Management District issued a modified Stage 1 Water Shortage for Pinellas County, effective December 1, 2023. Pointe West's designated day is Thursday, before 10am and after 4pm. Please adjust your watering schedule accordingly or you may receive a violation notice and be subject to fines. For more information, see https://pinellas.gov/watering-schedule-and-rules/.

Borrowing from the Clubhouse: Residents are reminded that if you wish to borrow chairs or tables from the Clubhouse you are required to sign for them. When you want to borrow items, please ask a REC member. The sign-up sheet is in the storage room which is normally locked and can be accessed by the REC board members. If there is a Clubhouse event planned (dance, park dinner, other events) you will not be authorized to borrow tables or chairs.

Yellow Directory (Dial Directory): Please contact Donna in the office and let her know of any changes or additions that you would like made. The office number is 727-584-8924, and is located at Lot 5-L.

Pool Umbrellas: If you open an umbrella at the pool, PLEASE close it before you leave. We don't want any umbrellas damaged by unexpected storms. If you use it and don't close it, you may be responsible if it gets broken.

When in the common spaces, or at the pool, please use proper receptacles for your cigarette butts. They are scattered over the sides of the roads and sidewalks. They not only present a fire hazard when a lit cigarette is flipped onto the ground, but it detracts from the beauty of our Park.

Bicycles and Golf Carts - Reminder - please park your bicycles and golf carts in the designated areas only and not on the walkways or in front of the doorways. There is a bicycle rack to the left of the main clubhouse door, and golf carts should park in parking spots. Please keep the sidewalk areas clear and hazard free.

If you are leaving the Park for an extended period please remember to notify the office. Make sure your 'out of the Park' address and phone number are current. Also inform the office who has a key to your unit, if you have authorized anyone to park in your driveway etc. Our community looks out for one another so it is important that information about your unit is current.

Please DO NOT CHANGE programming for microphones, TV, and other electronic equipment. Evan McKay has programmed remote controls for ease of use at regular Clubhouse events.



Reminder about Bulletin Boards in the Activity Room - all notices must be dated and can be left up for 30 days. Notices without a date will be removed.



Valentine's Day Around The World

Talentine's Day is celebrated in many countries on the 14th of February. Here are some Valentine's Day superstitions from around the world and from history:

- If you find a glove on the road on Valentine's Day, your beloved will have the other missing glove.
- A kiss on Valentine's Day will bring good luck for the rest of the year.
- In Wales, people would carve wooden love spoons as gifts. Favorite decorations include hearts and keys symbolizing unlocking someone's heart.
- Argentina doesn't celebrate Valentine's Day on February 14. Instead, they celebrate 'Sweetness Week' from July 13th to the 20th. There's even a day just to celebrate friendships.
- Finland and Estonia celebrate friendships on February 14 by sending presents and cards that say, 'Happy Friends Day!'
- Iraqi Kurds celebrate Valentine's Day with a feast. They decorate red apples to represent the love story of Adam and Eve. The apples are believed to bring prosperity and love.
- People in Guatemala dance in the streets in a celebration of love on 'El Dia del Carino' -- the Day of Affection.
- China celebrates its version of Valentine's Day on August 14. Women prepare offerings of fruit in the hopes of finding a good husband. Couples will also go to temples to pray for continued happiness.
- Bulgaria celebrates the 'day of the winemakers' on Valentine's Day. Couples enjoy a glass of local wine as they celebrate their love.
- Spain's 'day of love', Feast of St. Dionysus, falls on October 9. People celebrate by making a 'macadora', a marzipan figurine, and having colorful street parades.
- In Norway, people write 'gaekkebrev' or 'joke letters' to each other. They create intricate paper cut cards and put a snowdrop flower inside. The 'joke' is that the letters must be sent unsigned. If the receiver of the letter guesses the author correctly, they get an Easter Egg. If they lose, they must give the sender an Easter Egg instead.
- Slovenians believe that St. Valentine is the patron saint of spring so February 14 marks the first day of working in the fields. There is also a belief that birds 'propose' to each other on Valentine's Day. Slovenian couples celebrate love on March 12 which is St Gregory's Day.
- Couples in the Philippines come together every Valentine's Day to get married on mass. Often the government sponsors these mass marriages as a public event that allows couples with limited resources to get married.
- Romanians celebrate Valentine's Day on February 24 with a combination of Valentine's Day and a spring festival. Young people go to the forests to pick colorful flowers as gifts and couples wash their faces with snow to bring good luck.
- People in the Czech Republic believe that a kiss under a cherry tree on Valentine's Day brings good luck. They celebrate Valentine's Day on May 1.
- During Victorian times, it was considered bad luck to sign your name in a Valentine's Day card.






