RECIPE OF THE MONTH:

EASY CORN CHOWDER

Ingredients:

1 medium potato, diced

1 medium white or yellow onion, diced

1 large can of cream-style corn

1 cup of evaporated milk

2 slices of bacon, cooked and chopped

Salt and pepper to taste

Directions:

- 1. Peel the potato and onion and dice into bite-size pieces. Put into a medium pot and cover with about an inch of water.
- 2. Heat until boiling, then simmer on low until the potato and onion are cooked.
- 3. Pour in the corn and evaporated milk. Mix well.
- 4. Add the bacon, then season with salt and pepper to taste. Continue cooking over low heat for 30 minutes.

Note: if the chowder is too thick, add more milk or water.

FROM THE OFFICE



It is hard to believe that we are already looking at February! On the 1st of the year came a rent increase. I am sending out letters; hopefully by March 1st the correct amounts will be paid. Basic math...add \$50 to what you were paying in 2023! If you pay for a parking spot, the fee was increased to \$50 a month.

We finally got some streets resurfaced and they look awesome. Thanks go to the rent committee for reminding Mr. Larson annually that they needed to be done! We had a same day notice that they were doing them; I sent out an email to those who have joined the Embassy MHP residents on Facebook; the Shuffle Club faced the biggest challenge, as they were the "host" team for that week. A few residents were inconvenienced; sometimes you just have to make the best of a bad situation, but if you feel better yelling about it, by all means, go ahead!

The park is still having problems with solicitors; I recently had an encounter with an officer from Largo PD, who was less than accommodating about our "No Solicitor" rules. I have arranged to meet with Officer Bowling, who is sort of Embassy's liaison with the PD, but I may make a formal complaint about this Officer. He actually told the person to just get a solicitor's license, then I couldn't do anything about him being in the park! For those of you who do not know this, the Park streets are privately owned by Mr. Larson and are not subject to the same laws as public streets. Because Mr. Larson owns the streets, I can enforce all Park rules on the streets, including walking your dog on them, speeding, not stopping for the stop signs, etc. These violations can lead to eviction. is not the end "goal", it is a last resort for residents who believe they are above the rules.

Regarding another park rule that is not being followed, if you plan to get a dog you need park approval BEFORE you get the dog; once approved, you need to supply the office with licensing and shot records, a photo, and make sure you understand the park rules regarding pets. If you are not in a pet section, you will need to be approved by the park attorney to justify why you need a dog. IF you have guests who plan to bring a dog, they must also be preapproved for the dog, or may be asked to leave. Guest's dogs must follow the same rules as approved for the residents-----under 40 pounds, certain breeds not allowed, on a leash at all times with a human on the other end, no excessive barking, clean up ASAP, etc. There is a whole section regarding pets in the Park Rules: Rule 17, page 18.

A reminder that all guest must be registered in the office, with valid photo ID and the length of their stay. Anyone staying over 30 days must do a background check or be approved by me.

The Clubhouse has been found with the doors unlocked several times. If you were given a key for an event, it is your responsibility to see that the lights are off, a/c is off, and all doors secured. Remember that the Clubhouse is to be kept at 73 degrees, so put on the a/c or heat as needed to maintain that temperature.

A reminder that we will be collecting matchbox cars and "squeeze" balls for the Largo PD all year long. They are kept in patrol cars to comfort kids who may be involved in an accident, a domestic abuse call, bullying, etc. They have a source for stuffed animals. There is a donation box in the office.

I would like to thank all of the residents who have been helping keep the 12th street dumpster area clean and the lids closed. With the past holidays falling on Mondays, which is a normal emptying day for the dumpsters, the trailer was put in front of the dumpsters for overflow. After the dumpsters were emptied, several residents took the time to empty the trailer into the dumpster. They are unsung heroes in my book!

Also need to remind everyone that you cannot put any type of plastic bags into the recycle bins! If you have recyclables in a plastic bag, you need to dump them into the bins, then discard the bag into the garbage bins. BETTER YET, take your cans over to the shuffle court by the Clubhouse; the Shuffle Club collects them as a money maker to help defray costs.

As most of you know, GPS brings guests into 1st street off of Frontage road. It is not the "best first impression" for new people coming into our park. I am in the process of having the entire fence line cleaned up, it's a work in progress as I type this article but is already looking better. The fence does not belong to Embassy. If you ever have to give someone an address on how to get here, give them 5000 East Bay, which brings them to Tri-City Plaza, then guide them down Pine Forest into the park. "You only have one chance to make a good First Impression" and first street is not ours!

I want to thank Big Mike, he goes out every day with a "grabber" tool and picks up discarded items throughout the park, such as flying plastic garbage bags, cans and bottles thrown on the ground, papers, etc. Mike is fighting several health issues, but he continues to do this to keep YOUR park looking better. This is an example of how 1 person can make a difference, imagine what 10 people can do?

We have great respect for the Social Committee who oversees all of the events in the park and manages to keep things operating reasonably smoothly.


